IN CASE OF INITIAL/PRESUMPTIVE POSITIVE

- 1. Inform the State Board of Animal Health, Dairy Program. If it's a weekend a voice mail is appropriate. The number is 317-544-2392.
- 2. Use the original sample to perform any additional testing. Make sure each sample is the best representative sample for the load. If you feel you need to take another sample, permission must be obtained from Deb Hall (317-694-7031) or Tom Ford (317-694-3433).
- 3. The same test must be run at each step including finding the producer responsible and the same producer negative test.
- 4. Run the sample in duplicate along with a positive and a negative control. If either one of the samples is positive, the truck is positive. If both samples are negative the truck is negative and the milk may be used. Report this to BOAH using the Report of Initial Positive Form.
- 5. A certified NCIMS laboratory or a Certified Industry laboratory must run a confirmation test, using the same test kit, by running the same sample in duplicate with a positive and a negative control. A certified or CIS lab must find which producer is positive by running all the producer samples on the load.
- 6. Fill out the Report of Producer Positive form. You will fill in sections 1, 2 and 3. Do not forget to fill in the space concerning load disposition and the witness to disposition.
- 7. If you're sending the samples and load to another facility for confirmation, send the partially filled out Report of Producer Positive form along with the producer samples and the confirming lab will finish filling out the form. Keep a copy for your records.
- 8. Fax a copy of each form you've filled out to 317-974-2011.
- 9. When you get a producer negative test result, the Dairy Program must be informed prior to the milk being picked up again. A phone call followed by a fax of the test results is required. Number 6 on the above form must be filled in and refaxed to 317-974-2011.
