

Reportable Diseases of Small Animals

Effective January 1, 2015 345 IAC 1-6-2

Reporting of the following diseases to the State Veterinarian must occur within 2 business days:

- **Owner/caretaker or Veterinarian:** must report animals showing clinical signs of diseases in **bold**.
- **Diagnostic Laboratory or Veterinarian:** must report diagnosis of any disease listed.

Small Animals (Canine and/or Feline Patients)
