Muskie

- One of Indiana's longest standing Muskie fisheries first stocked in 1974.
- Brookville has produced several past state record Muskie with fish topping 30 pounds and 47".
- Largely untapped fishery with low pressure despite a thriving Muskie population.
- Anglers report success trolling crankbaits within the lakes many timbered coves.

Other Species

Walleye

- One of Indiana's premiere Walleye fisheries supporting fish in excess of 10lbs and 30".
- 2017 Broodstock netting collected over 1,500 Walleye greater than 14".
- Best Walleye action is in May casting jigs tipped with live bait on shallow water structure and sandy flats.

Black Bass

- Abundant Largemouth Bass up to 23" and Smallmouth Bass up to 21" have been caught.
- Smallmouth Bass abundance is the highest in the lower reservoir (below Causeway Road), while Largemouth Bass are more abundant in the upper reservoir.

Striped Bass

- Stocked annually with 52,000+ pure Striped Bass.
- Routinely produces fish in excess of 30" with historical catches up to 38" and 26lbs.

About the Area

- 5,260 acre Army Corps of Engineers Reservoir
- Home to two State Recreation Areas: Mounds SRA and Quakertown SRA.
- Located in scenic Whitewater River Valley that hosts a diversity of additional recreational opportunities.
- Tailwater fishery below reservoir for Rainbow and trophy Brown Trout in excess of 20".
- Lodging available in nearby town of Brookville, IN


