**LOCATION OF TIMBER:** Sec's 10&11, T4S, R2E. This sale is on the main body of Harrison Crawford State Forest – halfway between Leavenworth and Corydon on SR 62. Turn onto SR 462, cross the bridge over Blue River and travel about 3 miles to the entrance to the state property and turn left onto Cold Friday Road. Travel about 1.5 miles to the sale which is on the slope south of the horse camp on the right side of Cold Friday Road.

**REMARKS:** Trees are marked with red paint. Cutting and skidding must take place from **November 16, 2009 through March 31, 2010 and/or November 16, 2010 through March 31, 2011**. Logs in yard may be moved at all times of the year up until **June 1, 2011**. Den trees and large snags are marked with pink D's and S's. Prime trees are numbered and circled. Two log yards are designated – one on the north end by the horse camp, and one on the south side by the pond. This sale is on the road with very little distance of haul road. Recreation trails will be kept clear of debris. Buyer will be required to seed and straw the log yard and major skid trails at the forester's discretion depending on amount of soil erosion potential due to wet weather. Any damage to trails and fire lanes must be repaired by sale's end. There must be an operational bulldozer on site during the course of active skidding on the sale for cleanup of skid trails. This sale was marked **prior** to Hurricane Ike and the ice storm. Therefore, there are several marked trees that were damaged, and this will reduce the actual volume some amount from what the tally shows.
