REMARKS: This sale contains 59, primarily tree-length, logs salvaged from several events. Most of the trees were blown down in the August 4, 2009 wind storm. One of the large walnut trees, which was salvaged from Compartment 4 Tract 21, had been severely damaged by skidding in a 2009 timber harvest. Very few of the trees were also salvaged from the 2007 drought and the linden looper epidemic. Many of the trees are higher volume and excellent quality.
