**Remarks:**

A pre-harvest conference must be attended 3 days prior to the start of any logging operations. Cutting and skidding is only allowed from October 1st through March 31st of each calendar year unless otherwise agreed upon in writing by both parties. Logs in the yard and staged along major skids may be moved at any time of the year. The Buyer will provide a bulldozer and operator on site at all times during operations. Wet weather may delay harvest operations. Ruts must be leveled before rain events. Haul road must be maintained and buyer may be required to provide additional stone if needed.
