The State of Indiana, Department of Natural Resources – Division of Forestry serves as the Group Entity / Group Manager and is responsible for ensuring compliance with the applicable FSC standards, policies, procedures, and guidelines. The Group Entity maintains a COC Procedures Template Manual utilized by group members. The Group Entity developed and updates a Controlled Wood Risk Assessment used by all members that verify controlled material. The Group Manager provides FSC COC training and consultation services to members.

Management system (e.g. training programs for internal auditors, internal audit schedule, etc.)	 The management representative is of the group entity is Jeff Settle. Each member company has its own FSC administrator. Each member company has an FSC procedures document (Documented Control System or DCS) based on a template provided by the group entity. Personnel responsibilities and training are documented in the DCS and annual updates. Records are kept as paper and electronic files for at least five years. The group's FSC Product Group List clearly presents each member site's product codes and control systems.
Material sourcing (i.e. eligible inputs, supplier info, transfer of material between sites, etc.)	 The suppliers are verified at least annually by the member companies as having valid FSC COC/CW certificates. 15 companies have controlled material verification programs based on a centralized CW Risk Assessment developed by the Group Entity.
Management of non- conformities	The Group Manager uses internal audit forms, including CAR forms, based on SCS templates. The group uses the same hierarchy of non-conformities as SCS.
Site relationships, addition/removal process	The Group Manager has authority to add/remove participating sites based on eligibility requirements found in Group Entity Procedures.
