1. Brachiopod

3. Horn Coral

- A. Related to the octopus. Its name means “head-foot.” It’s a common fossil found in Ordovician rocks in our region. Not extinct, but modern animals don’t resemble this one.
- B. State Fossil of Kentucky, the upper shell is different from the lower one. It is not extinct.
- C. Has three lobes: front, middle, and back—or, left, center and right. An extinct distant cousin to the pill bug.
- D. Its common name—sea lily—implies a flower but it’s an animal related to starfish. Not extinct.
- E. Can be described as an armored sea anemone. Its common name is after its body shape. Extinct.
