The Water Shortage Task Force has been charged with developing water use priorities to be implemented during periods of water shortage. These priorities require implementation of potentially controversial use requirements; however, Senate Bill 369 requires the Task Force to make such judgments based on current information available. The priorities established are based on that knowledge. The Task Force also recommends that public agencies and private purveyors implement policies to encourage users to make wise decisions regarding water management.
