Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.1 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 8<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 0.1 percentage points over the year, which ranks 35<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 51 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 65.0% vs. 62.7% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have grown 27,600 over the year.
