

# February 2019 Beyond the Numbers...

*Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report*

---

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.1 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Total private employment reached a preliminary record highpoint of 2,747,600, which is 15,500 above the official December 2018 peak. The new December 2018 peak is subject to monthly revisions and annual benchmarking.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 57 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 65.2% vs. 63.2% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have grown 40,400 over the year.
