- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.5 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 8th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has decreased by 3,255 over the year and is at 3,396,036.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 67 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 64.4% vs. 63.4% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have decreased by 800 over the year.
