- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.4 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 4th in the U.S.
- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 0.5 percentage points over the year, which ranks 13th in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 45 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 63.7% vs. 63.0% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have grown 28,200 over the year.
