- Indiana's labor force has decreased by 11,702 over the year and is at 3,392,608
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 66 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 64.4% vs. 63.4% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have decreased by 1,300 over the year.
