Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.1 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has increased by 10,028 over the year and is at 3,394,817.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 60 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 64.8% vs. 62.9% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have grown 37,000 over the year.
