- Indiana's unemployment rate has increased 0.6 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 25<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has increased by 19,916 over the year and is at 3,393,789.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for three months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 64.3% vs. 61.5% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have decreased by 182,200 over the year.
