Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.0 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 10th in the U.S.
- Total private employment reached a preliminary record highpoint of 2,714,800, which is 25,900 above the official December 2017 peak. The new November 2018 peak is subject to monthly revisions and annual benchmarking.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 54 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 65.1% vs. 62.9% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have grown 25,900 over the year.
