

# November 2019 Beyond the Numbers...

*Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report*

---

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.4 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has decreased by 8,128 over the year and is at 3,384,046.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 64 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 64.4% vs. 63.2% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have grown 8,100 over the year.
