Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.1 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 9th in the U.S.
- The number of Indiana's ongoing regular unemployment insurance claims is the lowest since 1976, when UI claims were first recorded.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 52 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 65.1% vs. 62.7% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have grown 26,400 over the year.
