Re: Furlough at the DoubleTree by Hilton South Bend

Dear Ms. Gatlin:

I am writing on behalf of the DoubleTree by Hilton South Bend (hereinafter "the Company") to give you notice that there will be a total closure or type of closure of the DoubleTree by Hilton South Bend, located at 123 N. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd, South Bend, Indiana 46601 on March 27, 2020. This closure is expected to be temporary and will affect all employees.

While we believe the furlough to be temporary and may not trigger state or federal WARN Act notice requirements, we do not know what the future will hold at this juncture and are providing the following information to ensure you are fully informed and in an abundance of caution. Should any notice be required, notice was given as soon as possible given the unforeseen circumstances of a loss in business due to the unprecedented COVID-19 pandemic, the National Emergency declared by the President of the United Sates, and the State of Emergency declared by the Governor of Indiana. The COVID-19 pandemic has crippled the Company's business and businesses around the Country causing notice to not be foreseeable at the time that notice would have been required to be given.

All affected employees have been notified of their furlough dates and that their furlough from employment is believed to be temporary. Employees are expected to be furloughed from employment beginning on March 13, 2020, with all furloughs completed by March 27, 2020.

Attached is a list of the job positions and number of individuals who will be affected by the layoff. Furloughed employees do not have bumping rights.
