Dear Ms. Long:

This letter is being issued pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("WARN") to notice the Department of Workforce Development, Dislocated Worker Unit that Jeffboat LLC ("Jeffboat") intends to conduct layoffs at its shipyard facility located at 1030 East Market Street, Jeffersonville, IN 47130. Layoffs are expected to begin on or about April 2, 2018 and continue through May 14 of 2018. Approximately 207 employees will be affected in total. We currently expect to close the facility on or about May 14, 2018.

A list of the affected job classifications and number of affected employees in each classification is attached as Exhibit A. The majority of the affected employees are represented by the General Drivers, Warehousemen and Helpers, Local Union No. 89, affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen and Helpers of America ("Teamsters"). Notice regarding the layoffs has been sent to Mr. Jim Kincaid, Teamsters Local 89, 3813 Taylor Blvd., Louisville, Kentucky 40215. Bumping rights are governed by the collective bargaining agreement.
