In order to be considered for the 2020-2021 list of Indiana's Promoted Industry Certifications, applications must be submitted by December 15, 2019.

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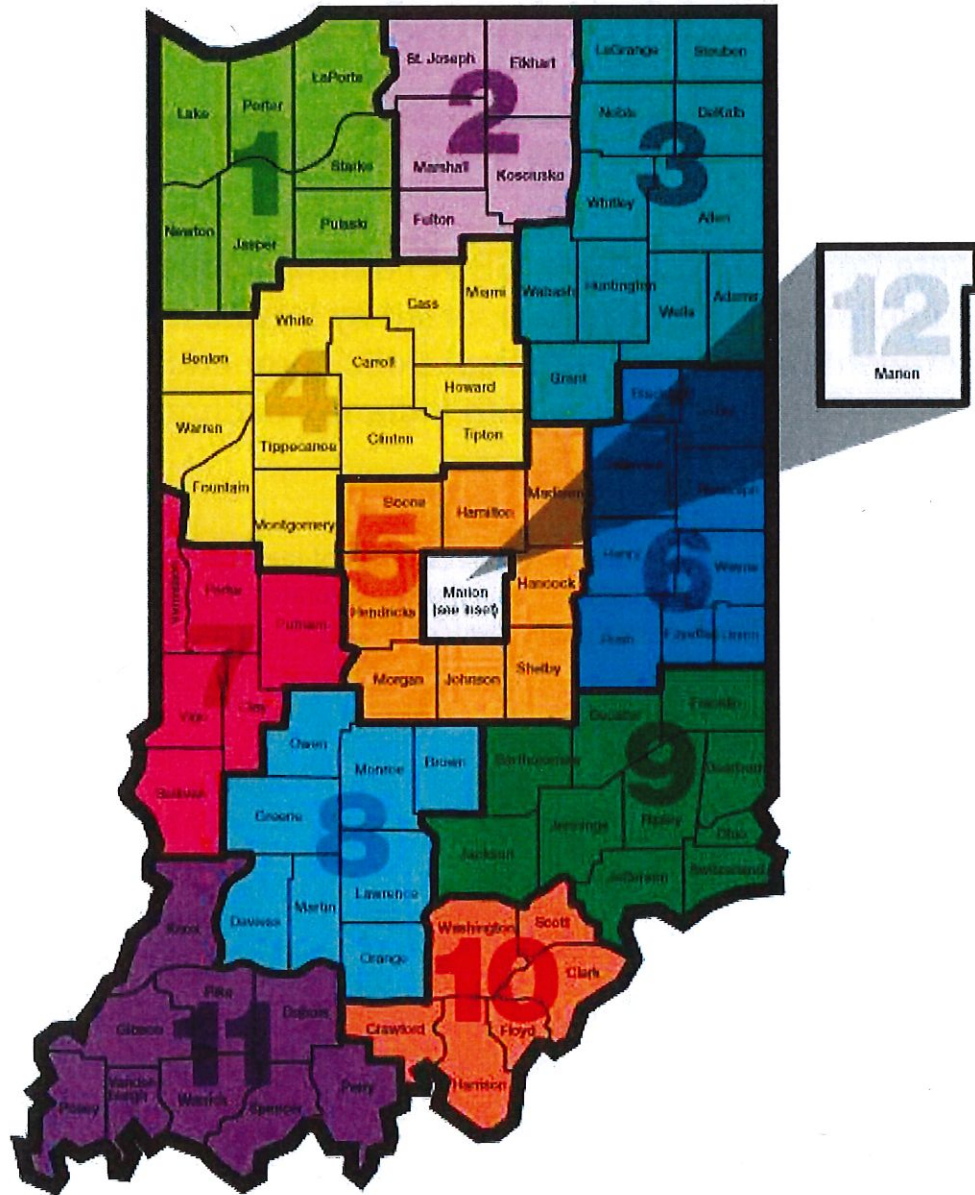

The criteria that will be utilized to evaluate each certification's eligibility for graduation pathways is listed below:

Criteria for Promoted Indiana Industry Certification to Qualify for Graduation Pathways
