WARN NOTICE

RE: POET Biorefining - Cloverdale, LLC - Federal WARN Notice

To Whom This May Concern:

This notice is being provided pursuant to the Federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 et seq. ("WARN Act"), to inform you that POET Biorefining – Cloverdale, LLC (hereinafter the "Company") has decided to cease production operations indefinitely and that a mass layoff at its facility in Cloverdale, Indiana shall occur. Please find below all information required to be provided to relevant government authorities pursuant to the WARN Act:

- 1. The name and address of the employment site where the plant closing or mass layoff will occur, and the name and telephone number of a company official to contact for further information.
 - a. The Company's facility located at 2265 E County Road 800 South, Cloverdale, IN 46120.

- 2. A statement as to whether the planned action is expected to be permanent or temporary and, if the entire plant is to be closed, a statement to that effect.
 - a. The Company will idle production operations at its facility located at 2265 E County Road 800 South, Cloverdale, IN 46120. As a result, a mass layoff shall occur. This action is expected to be permanent with no plan to resume operations in the future. A small portion of the facility shall continue to operate for purchasing and storing product there, but actual production shall cease indefinitely.

- 3. The expected date of the first separation, and the anticipated schedule for making separations.
 - a. All employees who shall be laid off are expected to be terminated effective October 18, 2019.
- 4, The job titles of positions to be affected, and the number of affected employees in each job classification.
