This required legal notice is being provided in accordance with the WARN Act, 20 CFR Part 639.

As previously disclosed publicly, West Pharmaceutical Services, Inc., a Pennsylvania Corporation, ("West") intends to close its Frankfort, Indiana Contract Manufacturing Facility (the "Frankfort Plant"). As a result of this closing, virtually all employees employed primarily at the Frankfort Plant will be terminated. Therefore, West has determined that a notice under the WARN Act may be required and is providing you with additional information regarding the Frankfort Plant closing.

- 1. The Frankfort Plant is located at Tech Group North America, Inc. d/b/a West, 2810 West State Road 28, Frankfort, IN 46041-9197.
- 2. It is expected that the Frankfort Plant closing will commence not prior to October 1, 2018. Additional terminations are expected to continue in accordance with the schedule attached to this Notice as Exhibit I. Exhibit I also contains the job title and number of employees in each affected position.
- 3. All terminations of employment are expected to be final and not temporary.
- 4. Employees do not have "bumping rights" in connection with the Frankfort Plant Closing. This means a senior employee cannot replace a more junior employee even if the senior employee is qualified. All decisions as to the timing of each individual's termination of employment are subject to West's sole and absolute discretion, subject to any applicable legal requirements.
- 5. The employees are not represented by any labor union.

Each affected employee will be eligible for severance benefits, which include continued pay, outplacement assistance and a requirement to execute a release in favor of West, in accordance with West's severance pay policies.
