

# July 2018 Beyond the Numbers...

## *Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report*

---

- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 7.2 percentage points since July 2009 (the low point of employment), which ranks 6<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's unemployment rate has decreased 0.2 percentage points over the year, which ranks 26<sup>th</sup> in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force participation rate has outperformed the national average for 50 months in a row. Indiana's rate is currently 64.8% vs. 62.9% for national.
- Indiana Private Sector jobs have grown 24,800 over the year.

### Construction Growth
