

## **PUBLIC WATER & SEWAGE – LOSS OF ELECTRICITY ONLY**

If a facility loses electricity, as long as their water and sewage are working properly, they can stay in the building until parents arrive to pick up children. Parents should be notified right away so that they can make a decision on whether to leave the children or come and get them. The facility cannot do food clean up without hot water and must use disposable dishes and utensils. If power is not back on by the next day, the facility **cannot reopen**.

## **PRIVATE WATER & SEWAGE – LOSS OF ELECTRICITY ONLY**

If a facility is on a well and not a public water source, the facility must contact parents within 2 hours to pick up their children. If power is not back on by the next day, the facility **cannot reopen**.
