Earlier this year, the Standardred Breed Development Advisory Committee and Advisory Board worked hard to put a proposal together encompassing plans for increased revenues from the addition of table games. However, due to the Covid-19 pandemic loss revenue from casino closures and adjusted revenue once reopened has caused us to revisit and amend original program we had proposed for 2020. Due to reduced funding, the Standardbred Breed Development Fund faced over a 33.68% reduction in revenue. The IHRC staff, Standardbred Committee and Advisory Board worked closely with racetrack management and ISA to create a workable program during these unprecedented times. This document outlines this amended program.

Overview of 2020 Program (Modifications made in bold)

Indiana Sires Stakes

Significant changes were made to the structure of the Indiana Sires Stakes program for 2019, and the new structure worked well. Overall, the program paid out over \$8.8 million in purses, an increase of over \$1 million from the amount paid in 2018. We would like to continue with this structure, only making minor improvements. The 2020 Indiana Sires Stakes Program will feature:

- Six legs for 2-Year-Olds leading up to a \$250,000 Super Final
- Seven legs for 3-Year-Olds leading up to a \$250,000 Super Final one leg was cancelled due to reduced funding.
- Super Final Participants finishing 6th through 10th will receive a \$4,000 purse payout each for earning their way into Super Finals
- \$25,000 consolations for all two and three year old categories.

Funding for the program will be structured as follows:

- Nomination fees will be retained by the Breed Development Fund. Nomination fees will remain at \$500.
- Entry fee for each leg will be \$500.
- There will not be an entry fee required for the Super Final.

- ➤ Breed Development will fund the purse, \$250,000 for the Super Final (for top ten horses from Leg Finals) plus the \$4,000 each 6th through 10th place finisher will receive. For a total payout of \$270,000.
- ➤ In legs with a field of 11 starters, an additional 6% of the purse will be paid with 3% to the sixth place finisher, 2% to the seventh place finisher, 1% to the eighth place finisher.
- ➤ Hoosier Park agrees to write overnight races for Sires Stakes eligible horses to provide additional racing opportunities. These races will run concurrent with the Sires Stakes program. Breed Development will earmark a minimum of \$500,000 from the funds allocated for IS Overnight/Mini Series Budget.

Breeder's Awards

Continue the current format from 2013.

- Total Payout for Breeder's Awards reduced to \$465,000
- A horse must win an eligible race to be eligible to the Breeder's Award Pool. The criteria is as follows:
 - Two & Three Year Olds ISB Horses only that win any race at the Pari-Mutuel Tracks in Indiana or ISFC Championship Races excluding any race in which the horse is entered for a claiming price.
 - o Four Nine Year Olds ISB Horses that win:
 - Final of any Breed Development Indiana Sired Late Closer Event
 - Elimination or Final of the Indiana Sires Stakes
 - Track's Open or Invitational Race
 - Excluding any race in which the horse is entered for a claiming price.
 - O Aged Horses (11 years old & older) IS Horses that win:
 - Final of any Breed Development Indiana Sired Late Closer Event
 - Elimination or Final of the Indiana Sires Stakes
 - Track's Open or Invitational Race
 - Excluding any race in which the horse is entered for a claiming price.
- Awards will be distributed to eligible breeder's based on the percentage win earnings of the total
 win earnings available. For example (please note that the example provided includes only a small
 sample of horses, there will be a much larger number of horses eligible for awards):

• Breeder's Awards will be paid on an annual basis, at the completion of the last race meet in Indiana.

Indiana Sired Overnight Supplements/Mini Series

Keep format of this program the same, however total amount available is \$1,935,000.

- Overnight races which fill with all Indiana Sired (or ISB) horses will be boosted by 15%.
- Hoosier Park will be allocated \$1,935,000 to fund overnight races/mini series which fill with all Indiana Sired horses. Once this allocation is met, the race track purse account will be responsible for funding any remaining races.
- Hoosier Park agrees to write overnight races for Sires Stakes eligible horses to provide additional racing opportunities. These races will run concurrent with the Sires Stakes program. Breed Development will earmark a minimum of \$500,000 from the funds allocated for IS Overnight/Mini Series Budget.

Indiana Sired Late Closers

- Total BDF Payout for Indiana Sired Late Closers \$150,000
- Purse Account contribution to remain at \$4,000 per leg
- Four late closing events which nomination payments have already been taken are kept, however the number of legs have been reduced from 2 to 1 to accommodate the shortened race meet. The remaining late closers have been cancelled, with Hoosier Park agreeing to write overnight events for these same classification. This will allow horsemen to still race in these events without the expense of an entry fee as well as allowing the track flexibility in scheduling. The funds allocated for these events have been moved to the Indiana Sired Overnight Supplement.

Indiana Sired Fair Circuit

The fair program continues to be an important part of the Indiana program. To address decreased revenue for 2020, the following modifications had to be made:

- Return to 2019 Purses for the Championship Races at the Indiana State Fair of \$20,000 and Consolation purses of \$8,000.
- Due to fair racing not being approved to begin until July 4, the Fair finals at the Indiana State Fair, typically held during the fair, will be held at a date in September at the State Fairgrounds.
- Contesting of 12 fair programs leading up to the finals held at the completion of the fair season at the Indiana State Fairgrounds.
- Elimination of series two for 2020.
- Elimination of overnight races added for 2020.
- Modify the number of starts required to enter Championship/Consolation races from 7 to 6.
- Pay \$500 to each 6th 8th place finisher in the Series 1 Championship races
- Approximately 12 racing programs to be held (not including ISA Elite Program, Grand Circuit races & Championships).



As discussed in our meeting on January 13th, Indiana Grand would like to propose a substitution within the approved 2020 capital plan. In reviewing the approved 2020 capital plan for Indiana Grand there are currently eight shuttle buses listed for purchase. Indiana Grand currently has eight shuttles. However, two shuttles are less than a year old and are not in need of replacement. Instead of spending money on replacing two new shuttle buses that will provide minimal impact to the racing business, the property would like to substitute the spend to purchase items that will have a larger impact on racing. Indiana Grand has two generators that support the racetrack lighting that are nearing end of life. The property would like to replace these generators in 2020. Additionally, Indiana Grand has the opportunity to improve the tote board indication (the electronic lights showcasing the odds/pools of each race) on both the main tote board and the paddock board.

The cost is as follows:

1) Generators for Race Track Lighting: \$110K (\$55K a piece)

2) Tote Board Indication: \$90K

I let

The total for the two proposed projects is \$200K. We propose substituting two shuttle buses at a cost of \$93K a piece (or \$186K in total) for the two projects noted above that would cost \$200K. Indiana Grand would actually be spending more capital in 2020 by purchasing the generators and revamping the tote board indication. It is important to note that the property would still purchase six brand new shuttle buses in 2020 which is more than enough based on current shuttle needs. We ask that the commission consider this request for approval of this substitution.
