Comes now the undersigned, and being duly sworn upon his oath, alleges and says as follows:

1. I am an adult, over eighteen (18) years of age, of sound mind, have personal knowledge of and am competent to testify as to the matters contained herein.
2. In 2014, I was the Presiding Judge of the Indiana Horse Racing Commission (the "Commission"). I commenced my duties on April 10, 1996. The Presiding Judge is the highest ranking judge.
3. As Presiding Judge, I, along with two associate judges, was responsible for ensuring that IHRC rules are enforced on a day-to-day basis. The judges work together to act as referee to all pari-mutuel thoroughbred and quarter horse racing in Indiana.
4. My review of information relating to the first race conducted at Hoosier Park on June 25, 2014 reveals that Jesse's Con finished first and was awarded a \$10,000.00 purse. The Program for Race 1 at Hoosier Park is attached to this Affidavit as Exhibit 1. The United States Trotting report showing the race

results and purse for Race 1 at Hoosier Park is attached to this Affidavit as Exhibit 2.

5. At all times relevant, Jesse's Con was owned by Marla Bednarsh, who was licensed by the Commission as an owner.
6. At all times relevant, Jesse's Con was trained by Jimmy Martin Rodgers, who was licensed by the Commission as a trainer.
7. Blood and urine samples were collected from Jesse's Con after the June 25, 2014 race.
8. On August 1, 2014, LGC Science, Inc. identified Sample No. 0044416 as being positive for tripeleennamine.
9. My review of information relating to the eighth race conducted at Hoosier Park on July 5, 2014 reveals that Jesse's Con finished third and was awarded a \$13,875.00 purse. The Program for Race 8 at Hoosier Park is attached to this Affidavit as Exhibit 3. The United States Trotting report showing the race results and purse for Race 8 at Hoosier Park is attached to this Affidavit as Exhibit 4.
10. At all times relevant, Jesse's Con was owned by Marla Bednarsh, who was licensed by the Commission as an owner.
11. At all times relevant, Jesse's Con was trained by Rodgers, who was licensed by the Commission as a trainer.
12. Blood and urine samples were collected from Jesse's Con after the July 5, 2014 race.


13. On August 1, 2014, LGC Science, Inc. identified Sample No. 0048055 as being positive for tripeleennamine.
14. The Judges notified Rodgers of the positive tests.
15. Rodgers declined to have a split sample tested for either result.

4. On or about June 28, 2014, urine and blood/serum Samples No. 0044416 taken from Hoosier Park on June 25, 2014, were received by LGC in good and secure condition.
5. LGC was engaged to perform an analysis of serum and urine Samples No. 0044416, which were collected after a race at Hoosier Park Racing and Casino on June 25, 2014.
6. In my role as the Laboratory Director at LGC, the testing of serum and urine Samples No. 0044416 were conducted under my supervision and control.

7. LGC testing determined that serum Sample No. 0044416 contained tripeleppamine at a concentration of 51 picograms per milliliter ("pg/mL"). Detection, identification and confirmation of the presence of tripeleppamine were performed utilizing liquid chromatography-mass spectrometry (LC-MS).

8. I sent an Affidavit to the Indiana Horse Racing Commission confirming these results on August 1, 2014. A true and accurate copy of that document is attached to this Affidavit and identified as Exhibit 9.

9. On or about July 9, 2014, urine and blood/serum Samples No. 0048055 taken from Hoosier Park on July 5, 2014, were received by LGC in good and secure condition.

10. LGC was engaged to perform an analysis of serum and urine Samples No. 0048055, which were collected after a race at Hoosier Park Racing and Casino on July 5, 2014.

11. In my role as the Laboratory Director at LGC, the testing of serum and urine Samples No. 48055 were conducted under my supervision and control.

12. LGC testing determined that serum Sample No. 0048055 contained tripeleppamine at a concentration of 30 picograms per milliliter ("pg/mL"). Detection, identification and confirmation of the presence of tripeleppamine were performed utilizing liquid chromatography mass spectrometry (LC-MS).

13. I sent an Affidavit to the Indiana Horse Racing Commission confirming these results on August 1, 2014. A true and accurate copy of that document is attached to this Affidavit and identified as Exhibit 13.

14. Attached Exhibits 9 and 13 reflect entries, reports, records and/or data compilations that were made at or near the time of the occurrence of the matters set forth in each of the records, by or from information transmitted by a person with knowledge of the existence of the matters recorded therein.

15. Attached Exhibits 9 and 13 and the entries, reports, records and/or data compilations that they reflect are, and were, kept in the course of regularly conducted business activities of the Commission.

16. Attached Exhibits 9 and 13 and the entries, reports, records and/or data compilations that they reflect are, and were, made and gathered as a part of the regular business practice and activity of the Commission.



**RECOMMENDED ORDER GRANTING INDIANA HORSE RACING
COMMISSION STAFF’S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

This matter comes before Administrative Law Judge Bernard Pylitt on Indiana Horse Racing Commission Staff’s Motion for Summary Judgment. Despite notice to Jimmy Martin Rodgers (“Rodgers”) of his right to file a Response in opposition, none was filed.

Following a careful review of the pleadings, Affidavits submitted in support of Commission Staff’s Motion, along with its Memorandum in support, ALJ Pylitt renders his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order GRANTING Commission Staff’s Motion for Summary Judgment. Any Finding of Fact more appropriately deemed a Conclusion of Law, or conversely, shall be so treated.

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

Rodgers was licensed as a Standardbred trainer by the Indiana Horse Racing Commission during 2014. Rodgers trained the Standardbred race horse Jesse’s Con which finished first in the first race at Hoosier Park on June 25, 2014, and was awarded a purse of \$10,000. Blood and

urine samples were taken from Jesse's Con following the race which were tested for unauthorized substances. Blood samples tested positive for Tripeleppamine at a level of 51 picograms per milliliter.

Rodgers was also the trainer of Jesse's Con which finished second in the eighth race at Hoosier Park on July 5, 2014, and was awarded a purse of \$13,875. Blood and urine samples were taken from Jesse's Con following the race which were tested for unauthorized substances. Blood samples tested positive for Tripeleppamine at a level of 30 picograms per milliliter.

On January 21, 2015, the Commission filed Administrative Complaint No. 215005 against Rodgers and recommended the following penalties:

1. Trainer Rodgers be fined \$500 for the presence of Tripeleppamine;
2. Trainer Rodgers be suspended for a period of 15 days;
3. Jesse's Con be disqualified and unplaced from first place in the first race at Hoosier Park on June 25, 2014, and was awarded a purse of \$10,000, and second place in the eighth race at Hoosier Park on July 5, 2014, and was awarded a purse of \$13,875; and
4. Owner Jimmy Rodgers is ORDERED to return the purse money earned by Jesse's Con in both races, and the Horsemen's Bookkeeper is directed to redistribute the purse.

Rodgers failed to file a timely request for a hearing following the issuance of the Administrative Complaint.

On March 9, 2015, Bernard L. Pylitt was appointed as the Administrative Law Judge to handle this matter.

The Commission Staff filed its Motion for Summary Judgment on August 17, 2015. On August 19, 2015, ALJ Pylitt issued a Notice to Rodgers at his last known address on file with the Commission that he had 30 days to file a Response under Indiana Trial Rule 56. Said Notice was not returned to the office of the ALJ indicating that Rodgers had moved.

On September 2, 2015, Hoosier Park Security advised counsel for the Commission Staff that he had contacted Rodgers who indicated that his new mailing address was 820 Edenbough Circle, Apartment 201, Auburn Hills, Michigan 48326. Rodger advised the Investigator that “Gorajec or that Woman down there, if they are going to send something they are just wasting a f..... stamp”.

On September 3, 2015, ALJ Pylitt sent a courtesy copy of the Notice to Respond by September 16, 2015 along with a copy of the Commission Staff’s Motion for Summary Judgment via certified mail, return receipt requested, and via first class United State Mail to Rodgers. The “green card” was received indicating that the certified mail was received on September 8, 2015.

On September 15, 2015 at approximately 2:30 p.m., an individual who identified himself as Rodgers left the ALJ a voicemail inquiring about the potential forfeiture of the purse based upon the pending Motion. Said inquiry was forwarded to the Commission Staff who returned Rodgers voicemail message.

On September 16, 2015, ALJ Pylitt received the following from Rodgers via facsimile (hereinafter “September 16, 2015 fax”):



Dear Mr. Pylitt:

After reading Administrative Complaint # 215005, I am confused as to why the Motion for Summary Judgment reads the Indiana Horse Racing Commission vs. Jimmy M. Rodgers with no mention of the owner. Why am I the only party mentioned? I am the trainer and received five (5) percent of the purse monies. The driver (P. Wrenn) received five (5) percent and the owner received ninety (90) percent totaling \$23,875.

I was under the impression that I would pay a \$500 fine, serve a 15 day suspension and return five percent of the purse money. The Summary Judgment conclusion reads a \$500 fine, 15 day suspension and reimbursement of purse monies. Since I am not the owner of Jesse's Con, I need clarification that the Indiana Horse Racing Commission will pursue the return of the purse money from the owner, Marla A. Bednarsh and that I am only responsible for the five (5) percent I received for being the trainer.

LEGAL STANDARD FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Indiana Rule of Trial Procedure 56 provides, in pertinent part:

(C) Motion and proceedings thereon. The motion and any supporting affidavits shall be filed in accordance with the provisions of Rule 5. An adverse party shall have thirty (30) days after service of the motion to serve a response **and any opposing affidavits. . . . A party opposing the motion shall also designate to the court each material issue of fact which that party asserts precludes entry of summary judgment and the evidence relevant thereto.** The judgment sought shall be rendered forthwith if the designated evidentiary matter shows that there is no genuine issue as to any material fact and that the moving party is entitled to a judgment as a matter of law. . . (emphasis added)

Ind. Code 4-21.5-3-23 is the Administrative Orders and Procedures Act provision that governs Summary Judgment motions. Section (b) provides that an Administrative Law Judge “shall consider a [summary judgment] motion ... as would a court that is considering a motion for summary judgment filed under Trial Rule 56...” I.C. 4-21.5-3-23(b)

RELEVANT STATUTE AND REGULATIONS

At all times relevant hereto, the following statute and regulations were in full force and effect:

Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-24(a) (2) provides that at any stage of a proceeding if a party fails to file a responsive pleading required by statute, the Administrative Law Judge may issue a written notice of a proposed default.

71 IAC 8-1-2 Foreign substances prohibited

Sec. 2. (a) No horse participating in a race shall carry in its body any foreign substance except as provided by these rules. A finding by the chemist or commission designee that a foreign substance is present in the test sample shall be prima facie evidence that such foreign substance was administered and carried in the body of the horse while participating in a race. Such a finding shall also be taken as prima facie evidence that the trainer and his or her agents responsible for the care or custody of the horse have been negligent in the handling or care of the horse.

(b) Upon a finding of a violation of this section, the owners or lessees of the horse from which the specimen was obtained shall forfeit any purse money and any trophy or award. However, forfeiture of any purse, trophy, or award for an overage of phenylbutazone, flunixin, ketoprofen, or furosemide in violation of these rules shall be consistent with Recommended Penalties of the Association of Racing Commissioners, International...

71 IAC 5-3-2 Trainer responsibility

(a) The trainer is responsible for:

(1) . . .

(2) The presence of any prohibited drug, medication or other substance . . . in absence of substantial evidence to the contrary, the trainer shall be responsible.

(b) The Trainer shall prevent the administration of any drug or medication or other prohibited substance that may cause a violation of these rules.

COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

On August 17, 2015, Commission Staff filed its Motion for Summary Judgment with Affidavits which set forth undisputed material facts to support the entry of Summary Judgment in the Commission Staff's favor. The Motion designated material facts contained within (1) the Affidavit of IHRC Executive Director Joe Gorajec (with attached exhibits); (2) the Affidavit of Timothy Schmitz, Presiding Judge of the Indiana Horse Racing Commission; and (3) the Affidavit of Dr. Richard Sams, Laboratory Director, LGC Science, Inc.

Rodgers failed to file any Response in opposition to Commission Staff's Motion for Summary Judgment, failed to designate any material issue of fact, or provide any opposing Affidavits. He simply sent his September 16, 2015 fax questioning the potential redistribution of the purse money.

Therefore, ALJ Pylitt concludes that there are no genuine issues as to any material fact that preclude the Commission Staff from receiving judgment as a matter of law.

UNDISPUTED MATERIAL FACTS

Jimmy Martin Rodgers was licensed as a Standardbred owner and trainer by the Commission in 2014. (Affidavit of Joe Gorajec ¶7 "Gorajec Aff.") Rodgers was the trainer of Jesse's Con, a Standardbred racehorse, which finished first in the first race at Hoosier Park on June 25, 2014, and was awarded a purse of \$10,000. Blood and urine samples were taken from Jesse's Con following the race which were tested for unauthorized substances. On June 25, 2014, Jesse's Conn specimens, labeled Sample No. 0044416, were sent to the Commission's primary approved laboratory, LGC Sport Science, Inc. ("LGC"), for analysis pursuant to the Commission's regulations. (Gorajec Aff. ¶14) Blood samples tested positive for Tripeleppamine at a level of 51 picograms per milliliter. (Gorajec Aff. ¶15)

Rodgers was also the trainer of Jesse's Con which finished second in the eighth race at Hoosier Park on July 5, 2014, and was awarded a purse of \$13,875. Blood and urine samples were taken from Jesse's Con following the race which were tested for unauthorized substances. Blood samples (No. 0048055) tested positive for Tripeleppamine at a level of 30 picograms per milliliter. (Gorajec Aff. ¶19)

After the race, and pursuant to 71 IAC 8-3-3(b)(2), post-race blood (serum) and urine specimens were taken from Jesse's Con. (Gorajec Aff. ¶12) On July 5, 2014, Jesse's Con specimens, labeled Sample No. 0048055, were sent to the Commission's primary approved laboratory, LGC Sport Science, Inc. ("LGC"), for analysis pursuant to the Commission's regulations. (Gorajec Aff. ¶14)

Rodgers, upon being notified of the positive test results and advised of his rights to have the split sample sent to an independent laboratory approved by the Commission, waived his right to have the split sample tested. (Gorajec Aff. ¶20; Affidavit of ¶¶9 and 10 "Schmidts Aff.")

Tripeleppamine is a substance foreign to the natural horse and are classified by the ARCI Uniform Classification Guidelines for Foreign Substances and Recommended Penalties and Model Rule, Version 7.00, revised January 2014^[1], as a Class 3 drug with a category "B" penalty classification ("Class 3-B foreign substance"). (Gorajec Aff. ¶20) 71 IAC 8-1-7, which was in full force and effect at all times relevant, directs the Commission to consider and impose penalties consistent with the ARCI Uniform Guidelines. The primary factors in determining the severity of a licensed trainer or owner's penalty are the number and recency of any past violations. (Gorajec Aff. ¶23) After further investigation, the Commission learned that Rodgers had not been sanctioned for any other incidents taking place within 365 days of the June 25,

^[1] The January 2014 Uniform Guidelines were in effect at the time of the race at issue. The Guidelines have been revised 15 times since January 2014, but Version 7.0 is applicable to the matter before the ALJ. No revisions occurred between January 2014 and July 24, 2014.

2014 race at Hoosier Park involving the presence of a foreign substances in a race horse for which he was responsible. (Gorajec Aff. ¶21) Taking all of these facts into consideration, the ARCI Uniform Guidelines recommends a penalty of a \$500.00 fine for each medication infraction, a minimum 15 day suspension, as well as disqualification of the horse, and redistribution of any purse won by the horse. (Gorajec Aff. ¶¶24 and 25)

RODGERS FAILED TO RESPOND OR DESIGNATE ANY MATERIAL ISSUE OF FACT IN DISPUTE

Rodgers' failed to submit a Response or provide any opposing Affidavits or designation in opposition as required pursuant to Rule 56.

Indiana courts have consistently determined that the requirement that a Response to a Motion for Summary Judgment and opposing Affidavits be filed is a "bright-line" rule. In *Desai v. Croy*, 805 N.E. 2d 844, 849 (Ind. Ct. App. 2004), the Court reviewed a line of cases that established this "bright-line" rule for trial courts and the parties who litigate Summary Judgment motions. The *Desai* court further held:

[W]here a nonmoving party fails to respond within thirty days by either (1) filing affidavits showing issues of material fact, (2) filing his own affidavit under Rule 56(F) indicated why the facts necessary to justify his opposition are unavailable, or (3) requesting an extension of time in which to file his response under 56(I), the trial court lacks discretion to permit that party to thereafter file a response.

Id. at 850

The Commission changed its rules during 2014. However, the Commission was under no obligation to notify licensees of rule changes. It was, and remains, the express obligation of a licensee to be aware of the rules regulating pari-mutuel racing in Indiana. 71 IAC 5-1-25 provides: "A licensee shall be knowledgeable of these rules and, by acceptance of the license,

agrees to abide by these rules.” Rodgers accepted a license from the IHRC, and he accordingly accepted the responsibility of being aware of and abiding by all Indiana rules.

Rodgers failed to designate any material issues of fact in dispute which would preclude the entry of Summary Judgment as a matter of law. The ALJ recognizes that the lack of an adequate response to a Motion for Summary Judgment does not automatically entitle the moving party to a judgment as a matter of law. *Countrywide Home Loans, Inc. v. Holland*, 993 N.E. 2d 184, 189 (Ind. Ct. App. 2013). Once the Staff filed its Motion for Summary Judgment, designating evidence and Affidavits to establish that there were no issues of material fact, the burden shifted to Rodgers to present evidence in a timely fashion with his Response as required by IND. R. TRIAL P. 56(C).

When the non-moving party fails to properly respond or designate evidence before the response deadline as required by Trial Rule 56, and the moving party has shown that it is entitled to Summary Judgment, Summary Judgment must be entered against the non-moving party as a matter of law. *Morton v. Moss*, 694 N.E.2d 1148, 1152 (Ind. Ct. App. 1998).

In Seufert v. RWB Med. Income Props. I Ltd. P’ship, 649 N.E.2d 1070, 1073 (Ind. Ct. App. 1995), the Court held that “If the non-moving party does not respond to a properly supported motion by setting forth specific facts showing a genuine issue for trial, then T.R. 56(E) mandates that summary judgment, if appropriate, be entered against him.”

**BASIS FOR RECOMMENDED ORDER GRANTING SUMMARY JUDGMENT
IN FAVOR OF COMMISSION STAFF**

The Indiana Pari-Mutuel Horse Racing Act (the “Horse Racing Act”), is codified at Ind. Code § 4-31 *et seq.* The Horse Racing Act provides that the purpose of the article is to “permit pari-mutuel wagering on horse races in Indiana **and to ensure that pari-mutuel wagering on**

horse races in Indiana will be conducted with the highest of standards and the greatest level of integrity.” Ind. Code § 4-31-1-2 (emphasis added).

The Indiana legislature provided specific direction to the Commission with respect to the illegal medication and/or drugging of racehorses. Chapter 12 of the Horse Racing Act makes clear that (unless specifically authorized by the Commission) there is an absolute prohibition against allowing a horse that has “drugs [and] medications or substances foreign to the natural horse” in its system to compete in a race without suffering an appropriate sanction. Ind. Code §§ 4-31-12-1, 4-31-12-2(a). That sanction includes the mandatory forfeiture of any purse that was earned as a result of the horse’s performance. Ind. Code § 4-31-12-13(b)(1). This absolute prohibition and the related legislative forfeiture directive have been incorporated into the applicable Commission regulations at 71 IAC 8-1-2.

The Commission Staff has shown that it is entitled to Summary Judgment as a matter of law since there are no genuine issues of material fact in dispute that: (1) a horse racing in Indiana is prohibited from having illegal foreign substances in its system at the time of a race; (2) Jesse’s Con had illegal foreign substances in his system at the time of the race; (3) Rodgers was responsible for the presence of these substances; and (4) the sanction recommended against Rodgers was reasonable and appropriate.

Once the Commission Staff met its obligation pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 56 and I.C. 4-21.5-4-23, the obligation shifted to Rodgers. Given the fact that Rodgers failed to respond or designate any genuine issue of material fact in dispute, the Commission Staff’s Motion must be granted as a matter of law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The IHRC acted within its statutory authority when it promulgated 71 IAC 10-2-3, pursuant to IC 4-31-13-2(a) and IC 4-31-12-15(a).
2. A horse racing in Indiana is prohibited from having illegal foreign substances in its system at the time of a race.
3. Jesse's Con had illegal foreign substances in his system at the time of the race at Hoosier Park on June 25 and July 5, 2014.
4. Jesse's Con's trainer, Jimmy Rodgers, was licensed as a trainer by the Indiana Horse Racing Commission during 2014.
5. Rodgers was the trainer of Jesse's Con, a Standardbred racehorse that participated in the first race on June 25, 2014.
6. Jesse's Con placed first in that race and was awarded a purse of \$10,000.
7. Rodgers was the trainer of Jesse's Con, a Standardbred racehorse that participated in the first race on July 5, 2014.
8. Jesse's Con placed second in the eighth race and was awarded a purse of \$13,875.
9. Rodgers was responsible for the presence of foreign substances found in Jesse's Con on June 25, 2014 pursuant to 71 IAC 5-3-2(2).
10. Following the race, post-race blood and urine samples were taken from Jesse's Con (No. 0044416) and sent to LGC Science, Inc. for analysis.
11. LGC Science, Inc. reported on August 1, 2014 that the sample tested positive for Tripeleppamine in excess of threshold limits.
12. Rodgers was offered the opportunity to have a split sample test but declined that offer.

13. Tripeleminamine is a substance foreign to the natural horse that is classified by the ARCI Uniform Guidelines as a Class 3 drug with a category “B” penalty. (“Class 3-B foreign substance”).

14. A positive test for a prohibited drug or substance is prima facie evidence of a violation of this rule. In the absence of substantial evidence to the contrary, the trainer shall be responsible.

15. 71 IAC 8-1-7, which was in full force and effect at all times relevant, directs the Commission to consider and impose penalties consistent with ARCI Uniform Guidelines.

16. The ARCI Uniform Guidelines recommend a \$500.00 fine for each Class 3-B violation.

17. The monetary sanction imposed by the Stewards against Rodgers was reasonable and appropriate since the ARCI Uniform Guidelines suggested a penalty of a \$500.00 fine for each medication infraction, disqualification of the horse, and redistribution of any purse won by the horse.

18. Jesse’s Con placed first in the first race and was awarded a purse of \$10,000 on July 25, 2014.

19. Jesse’s Con is disqualified from first place and the purse money it earned is forfeited, returned, and redistributed pursuant to the provisions of 71 IAC 8-1-2 (b).

20. Jesse’s Con placed second in the eighth race and was awarded a purse of \$13,875 on July 5, 2014.

21. Jesse’s Con is disqualified from second place and the purse money it earned is forfeited, returned, and redistributed pursuant to the provisions of 71 IAC 8-1-2 (b).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. A horse participating in a pari-mutuel race in Indiana is prohibited from carrying in its body any foreign substance that is not specifically authorized by Commission rules. I.C. 4-31-12-2; 71 IAC 8-1-1(a); 71 IAC 8-1-2.
2. A horse participating in a pari-mutuel race in Indiana is prohibited from carrying in its body Tripeleennamine in excess of 100 pg/ml. 71 IAC 8-1-4.2(21).
3. The Commission rules direct the Staff to consider the ARCI Uniform Guidelines in both classifying a foreign substance and when imposing penalties and sanctions. 71 IAC 8-1-7.
4. A finding at a Commission-approved laboratory that a test sample taken from a horse contains a foreign substance creates a presumption that “the procedures of collection, preservation, transfer to the laboratory, and analysis of the sample are correct and accurate.” 71 IAC 8-2-1(2).
5. The finding that a foreign substance is present creates a presumption that the foreign substance was in the horse’s body at the time the race was run. 71 IAC 8-1-2(a).
6. Positive laboratory tests are prima facie evidence that the foreign substance has been administered to the horse in violation of the Commission’s rules. 71 IAC 8-1-2.
7. A positive test creates a prima facie case that the trainer (or his or her agents) responsible for the care and custody of the horse were negligent in handling the care of the horse. 71 IAC 8-1-2(a).
8. There is a duty on the trainer to “prevent the administration of any drug or medication or other substance that may cause a violation of these rules.” 71 IAC 5-3-2(b).
9. The trainer is responsible for the condition of the horse regardless of any acts of third persons. 71 IAC 5-3-2(a)(2).

10. All IHRC licensees are responsible for knowing the rules that govern pari-mutuel racing in Indiana. 71 IAC 5-1-25.

11. Indiana law mandates the forfeiture of a purse when any prohibited substance is detected in a horse participating in a race. I.C. 4-31-12-13; 71 IAC 8-1-2(b).

12. The ARCI Uniform Guidelines recommend a \$500.00 fine for each violation involving a Class 3-B substance, such as Tripelethamine.

13. There is no genuine issue in dispute of any material fact with respect to any of the findings in Administrative Complaint No. 215005.

14. Additionally, Rodgers failed to file a timely request for a hearing.

ULTIMATE FINDING OF FACT


The findings by Industrial Laboratories clearly established that Trainer Jimmy Rodgers violated two Commission equine medication rules, specifically 71 IAC 8-1-2 and 71 IAC 8-1-4.2 (21).

RECOMMENDED DECISION

Based upon the findings of fact and conclusions of law herein, ALJ Pylitt recommends that the Commission Staff's Motion for Summary Judgment be GRANTED pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-23 (b).

Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-29(d), either party hereto, has 15 days following receipt of this Recommended Order to file written exceptions with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission.


