New Members Appointed to Indiana's Thoroughbred Breed Development Advisory Committee

Governor Mitch Daniels has appointed Wendy Brown, Steve Stults and Paul Tinkle to serve on the committee which advises the Indiana Horse Racing Commission on its Thoroughbred Breed Development Program. The appointments are for four year terms and begin January 1, 2011.

Lifelong horse enthusiast, Wendy Brown, has owned thoroughbred racehorses for thirty years and has participated in Indiana's pari-mutuel racing program since its inception in 1995. Wendy has also served as a Director of the Indiana HBPA from 1996 – 2008.

Thoroughbred owner, Steve Stults, is the Director of the Indiana HBPA Benevolence Trust.

Paul Tinkle has been involved in horse ownership for over 50 years. Paul bred multiple Grade I Stakes winner Jersey Girl. He is an ITOBA board member and the ITOBA Sales Manager.

The new appointees replace Jim Carmichael (deceased), Jim Elliott and Jim Hartman whose terms have expired.
