One of her many accomplishments was writing and passing the legislation that created the Indiana Commission for Women with Senator Vi Simpson. Governor Skillman approached the legislation as a collaborative, bi-partisan effort. "I've said so many times – most of the success we have in life, whether professionally or personally, is due to the strength of our relationships. I think the Indiana Commission for Women can be a great relationship building organization."

Skillman has helped lead the way for women's full participation in their communities. One way she had done this is through the creation of her *Advancing Hoosier Women in Business* seminar series that have been held in sixteen different communities across the state over the last four years. Women from all different stages

of life and experience have attended the events. She has been inspired to see how women rise to the challenge during very tough economic times. "The past two years have caused all of us to be more creative and innovate. I think women particularly fare very well when you are accustomed to improvising anyway."
