Naloxone Reporting Requirements Per Indiana Code

IC 16-31-3-23.7 (a)

Requires that any:

1. Law enforcement officer
2. Firefighter
3. Volunteer firefighter
4. Advanced emergency medical technician
5. Emergency medical responder
6. Emergency medical technician
7. Paramedic



Who: (1) administers an overdose intervention drug OR (2) is summoned after an overdose intervention drug is administered;

Must inform the emergency ambulance service responsible for submitting the report to the commission of the number of times an overdose intervention has been administered.

IC 16-31-3-23.7 (b)



Requires the emergency ambulance service to include this information on its run sheet and report it to the Indiana Emergency Medical Services Commission.
