

<b>Title</b>	<b>Metals in Water, Soil, or Waste</b>
<b>Test Explanation:</b>	Severe effects of metals toxicity include reduced growth and development, cancer, organ damage, nervous system damage, and in extreme cases, death.
<b>Specimen Requirements</b>	<p>Samples are accepted ONLY from Divisions of the Indiana State Department of Health, State Government Agencies or from County and Local Health Departments.</p> <p>Questions: Contact Marsha Rinehart, mrinehart@isdh.in.gov or 317-921-5559</p>
<b>Sampling Materials</b>	<p>For water samples use plastic bottles, the minimum volume is 125 mL.</p> <p>For soil samples use plastic bags or glass containers.</p> <p>For waste samples use glass containers.</p> <p>Contact laboratory for sampling containers.</p>
<b>Procedural Notes</b>	Complete the analysis request form. Note which metals are needed, e.g., Lead, Arsenic, Barium, Boron, Cadmium, Chromium, Copper, Iron, Manganese, Mercury, RCRA Metals, etc. Include, at a minimum, an email address for contact information.
