

To create a Query in ESSENCE:

- 1. Click on the Query Portal on the homepage.
- 2. Change datasource to the one you would like.
 - a. ER/ED data will be ER Data by Patient location or ER Data by Hospital Location
 - b. I-NEDSS closed case investigation will be Reportable Diseases Data
- 3. Change the time by adjusting the **start date** and **end date**.
- 4. On the left side, chose filters by selecting **Geography System** (Region/county or Zip Code) and/or Medical Group System.
 - a. ChiefComplaintSubSyndromes: groups of associated symptoms, like GI Bleeding
 - b. Syndrome: Group of associated symptoms, like Fever, that are made up of subsyndromes
 - c. ChiefComplaints: Free text search in the chief complaint parsed column
 - d. CCDD: Search in both the Chief complaint parsed column and discharge diagnosis column for key words (located further down in the **available query fields**)





- 5. Highlight the field(s) wanted and then click **select**. You will know the field(s) were selected if they show up in the right hand column.
 - a. To select multiple values, hold down the ctrl button while clicking with your mouse.



- 6. To run the Query, select time series or data details.
 - a. Time series will show a graph with dots that can be clicked on to open a line list of investigations.
 - b. Data details will show the line list of visits that meet the selected query.
