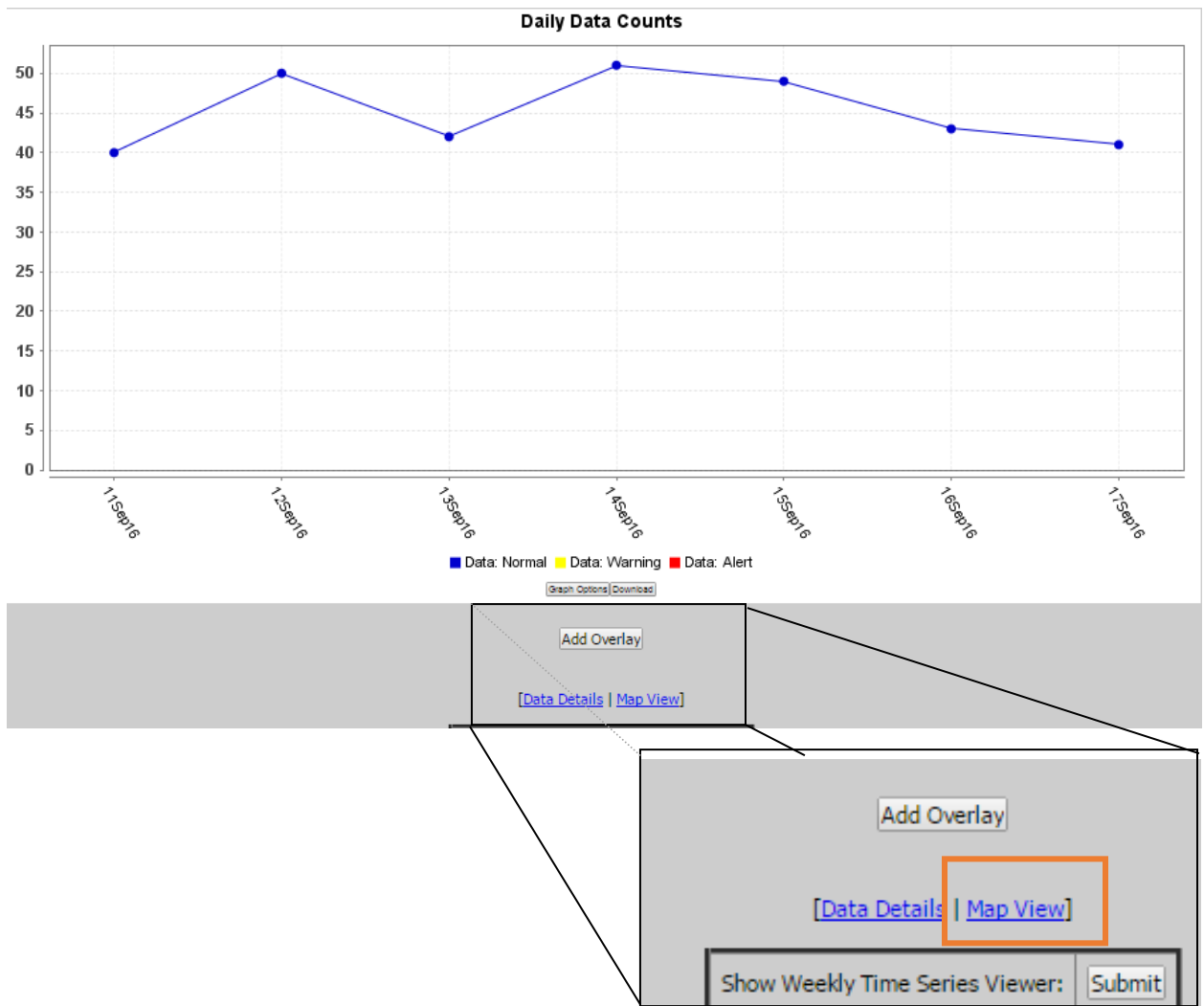
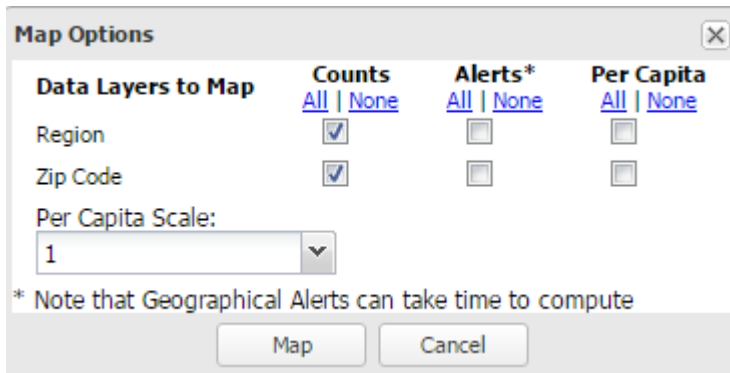


Viewing Data in a Map in ESSENCE

1. Create a query that you would like to see the data in a map. The following example is looking at St. Joseph County for the GI syndrome for 11/11/2016 to 11/17/2016.
2. Run the query so that you see the time series (See below). Click on the **Map View** button below the graph.
 - a. This will create a map view for the entire time frame of your query. If want to map a specific day, click on the dot to go to the data details. There is also an option on this page for **Map View** under the **available links** section.



- The **Map Options** box will pop up. Leave the default options and click “Map.”



- The map can take a little bit of time to load. Use the zoom in and out options on the left side to adjust the map size.

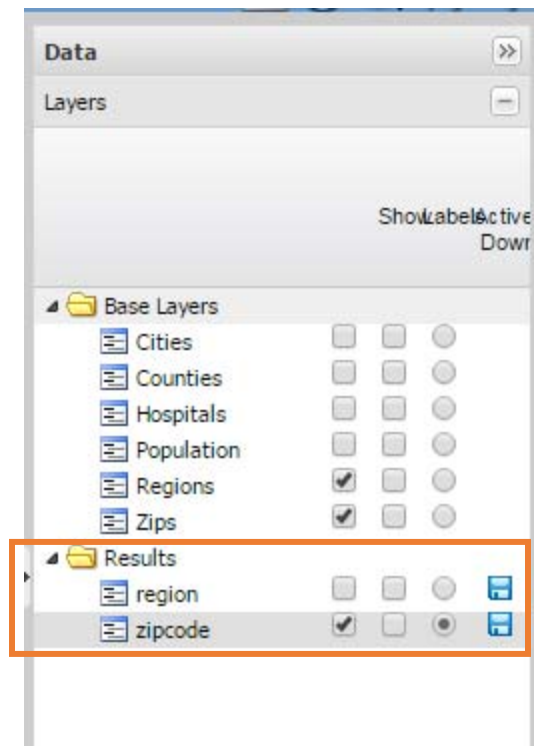


Figure 1: Map without Labels

- To change the results from County level counts to Zip code level counts, navigate to the right hand side of the page. Under **Results**, unclick the farthest left box from “region” and click the farthest left box for “zipcode.” Make sure it looks like the picture below (Figure 1).

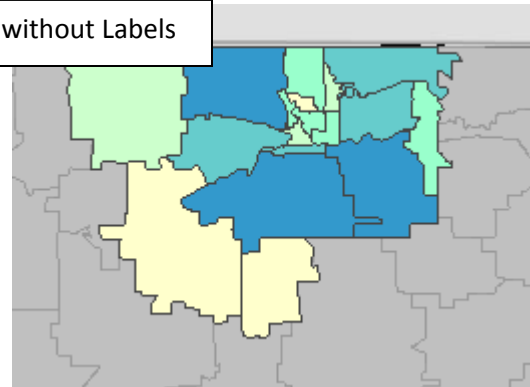


Figure 2: Map with Labels

- The farthest left square check boxes tells the map what layers and results to display. The middle squares, when checked, will label the map (Figures 1 and 2). Figure 2 shows zip codes and counts labeled.
