MIPA NVDRS Subcommittee

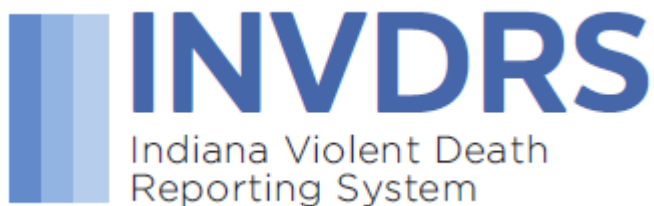
- Goals: facilitate mentoring and collaboration, regional data sharing
- Sharing of Death Certificates to ID:
 - Individuals involved in an incident that began in Indiana but death occurred in another state



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Certificate of Confidentiality

- Once approved, the CoC protects ISDH from being compelled to release identifiable information in response to legal demands at the federal, state, or local levels.

All data is preliminary



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Death Certificates-2015

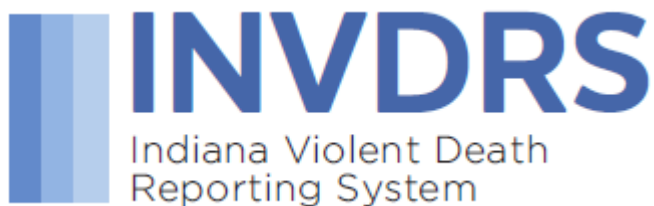
- 1527 cases statewide (as of 2/15 DC update)
 - 964 Suicides (63%)
 - 388 Homicides (25%)
 - 140 Undetermined (9 %)
 - 35 Accidental (2%)

CDC Timelines

- **98% of our Death Certificates were uploaded within 6 months of Death!**
- **Median days from death to initiation in INVDRS = 81 days**

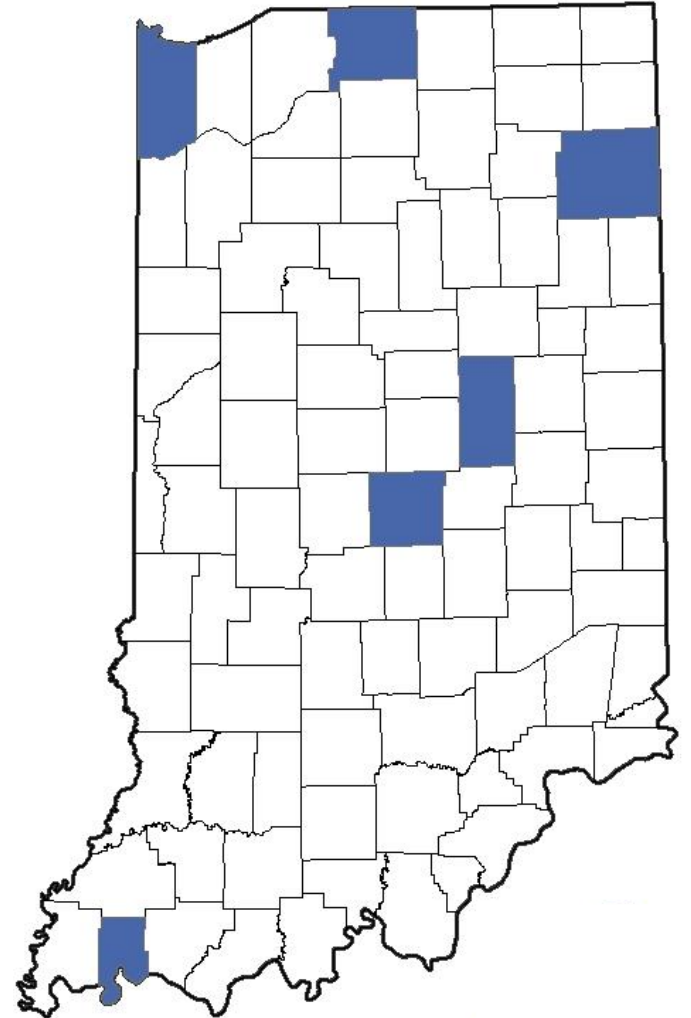


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Death Certificates

- Pilot Counties
 - 49.7% of all cases (759)
 - 41.5% of all suicides (400)
 - 77.8% of all homicides (302)

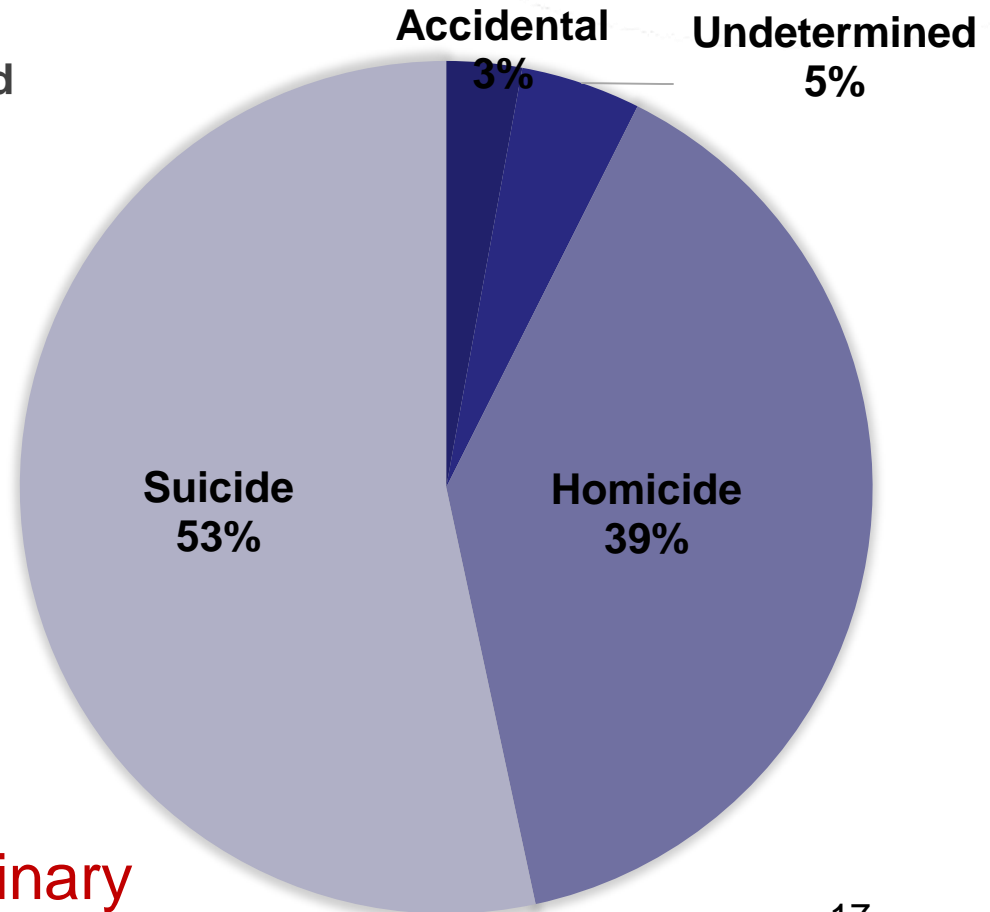
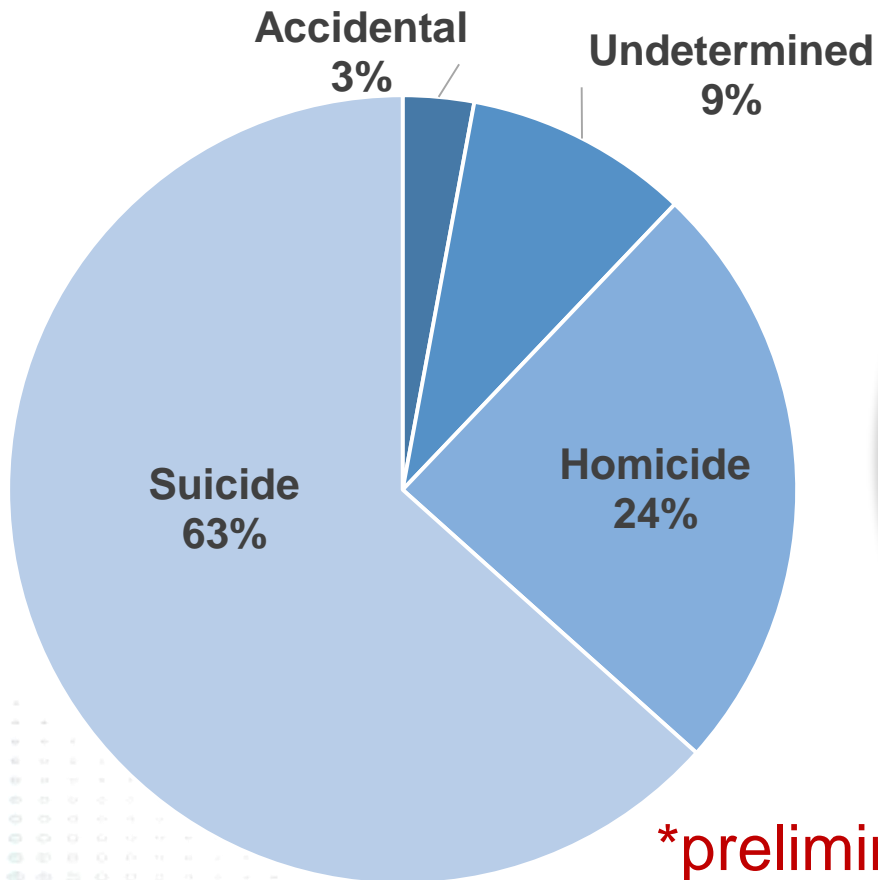


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Manner of Death

Pilot Counties

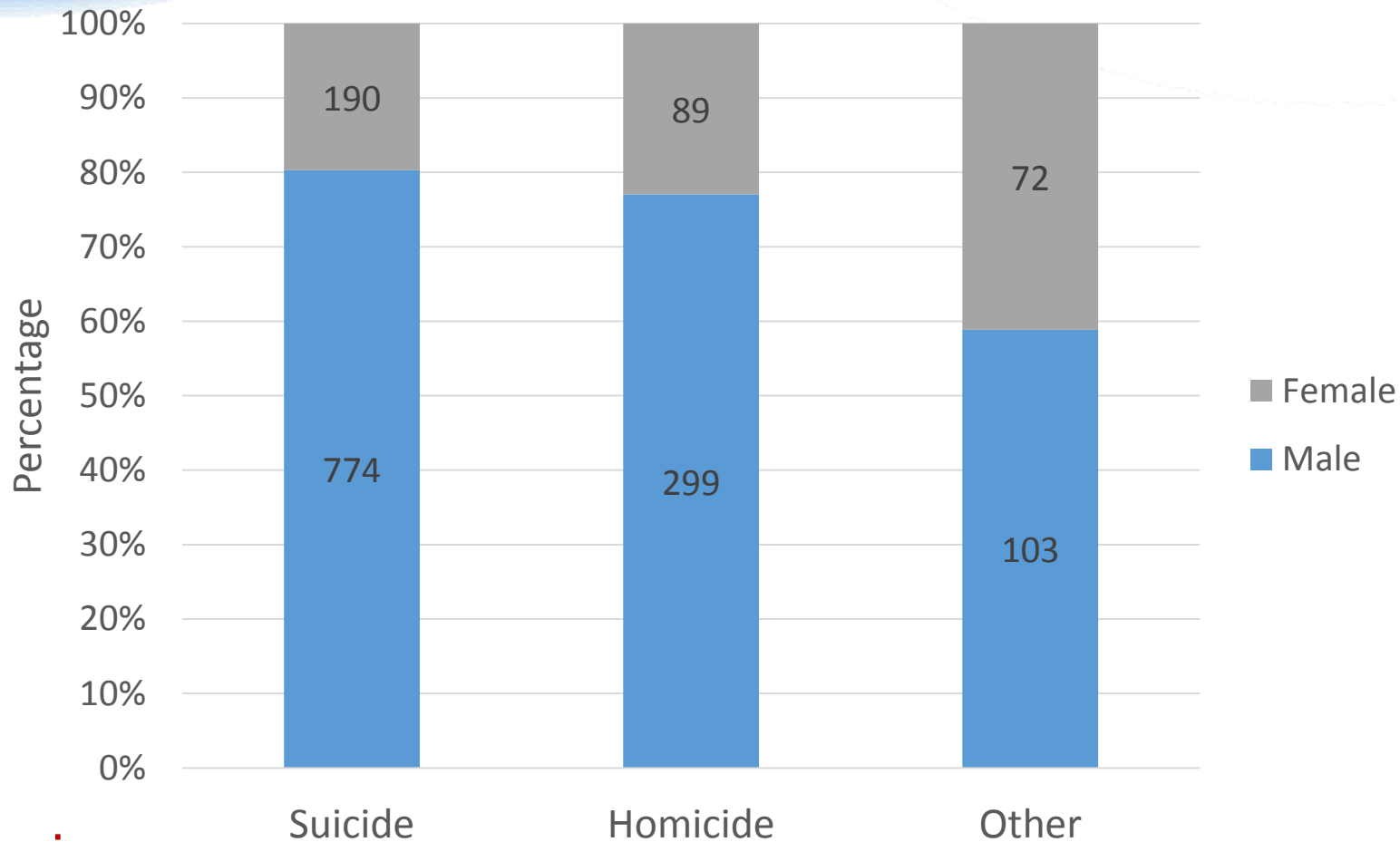

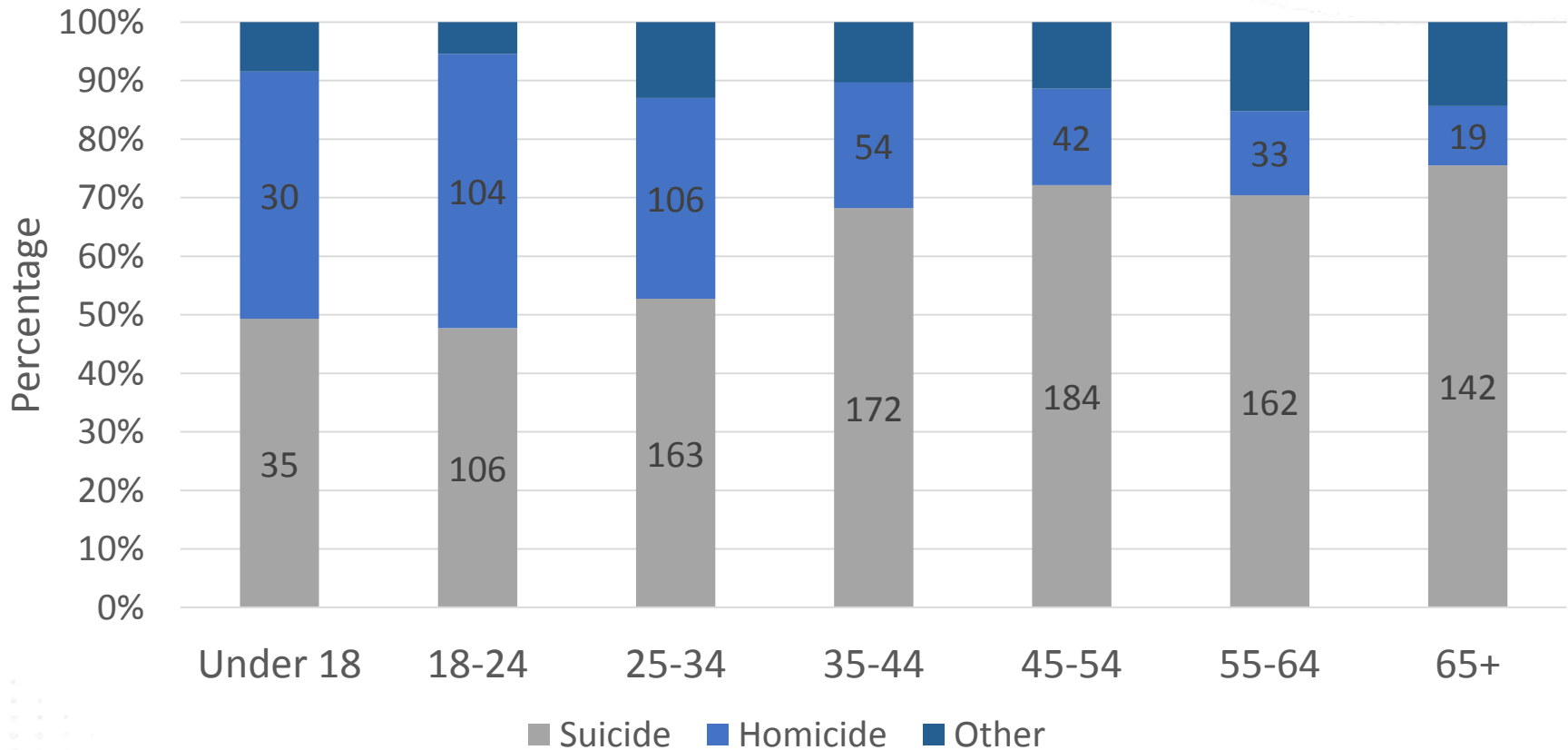

Manner of Death by Sex (Statewide)



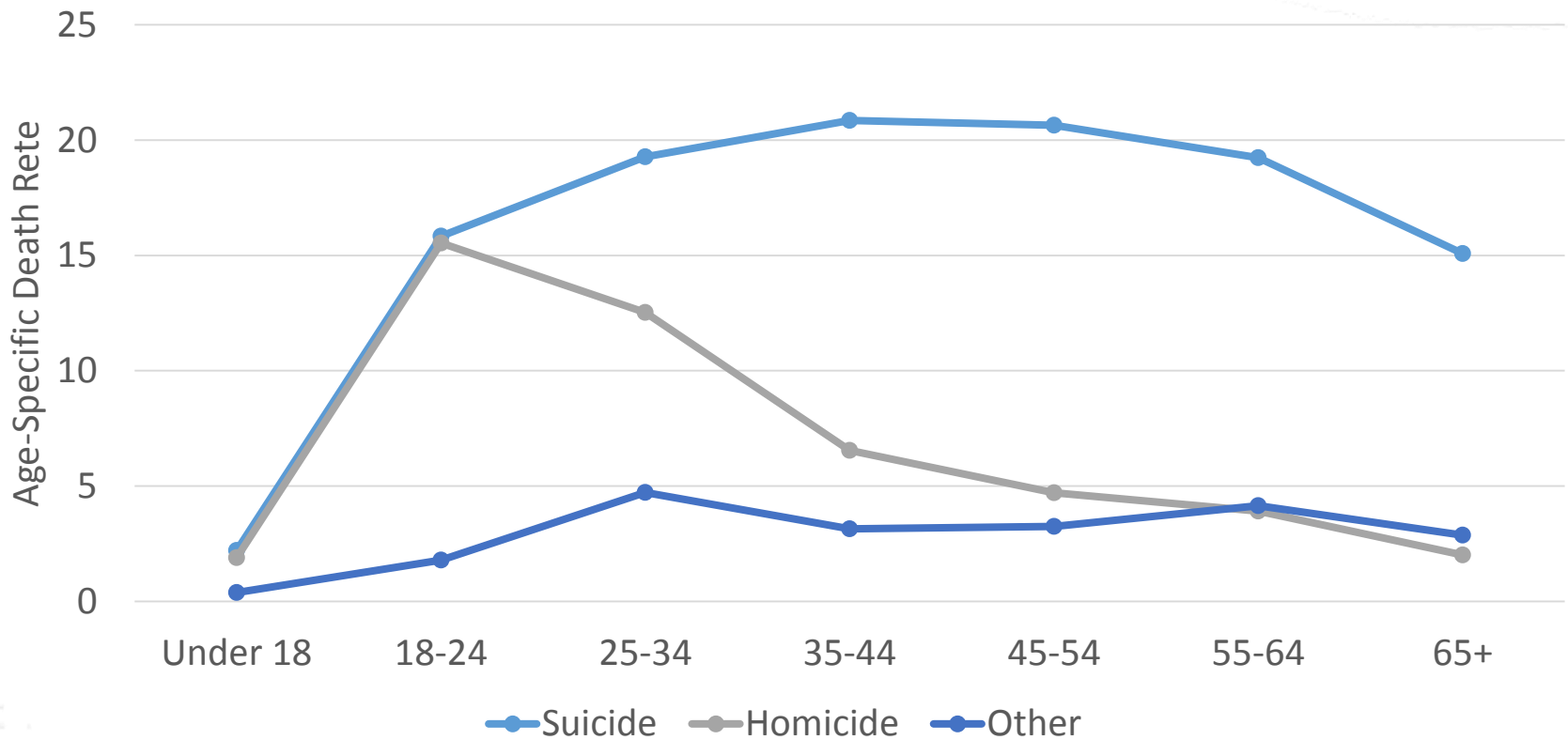

Manner of Death by Age Group (Statewide)



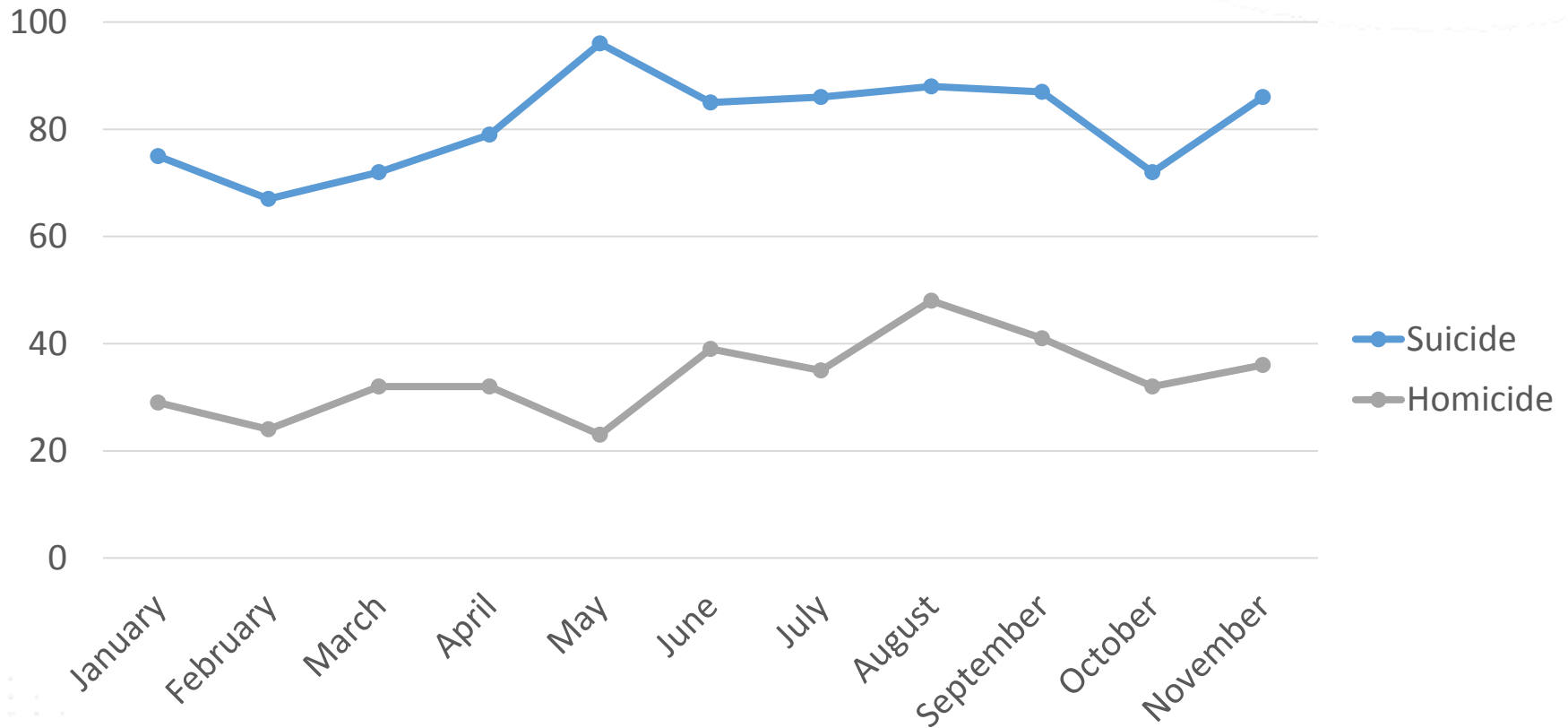

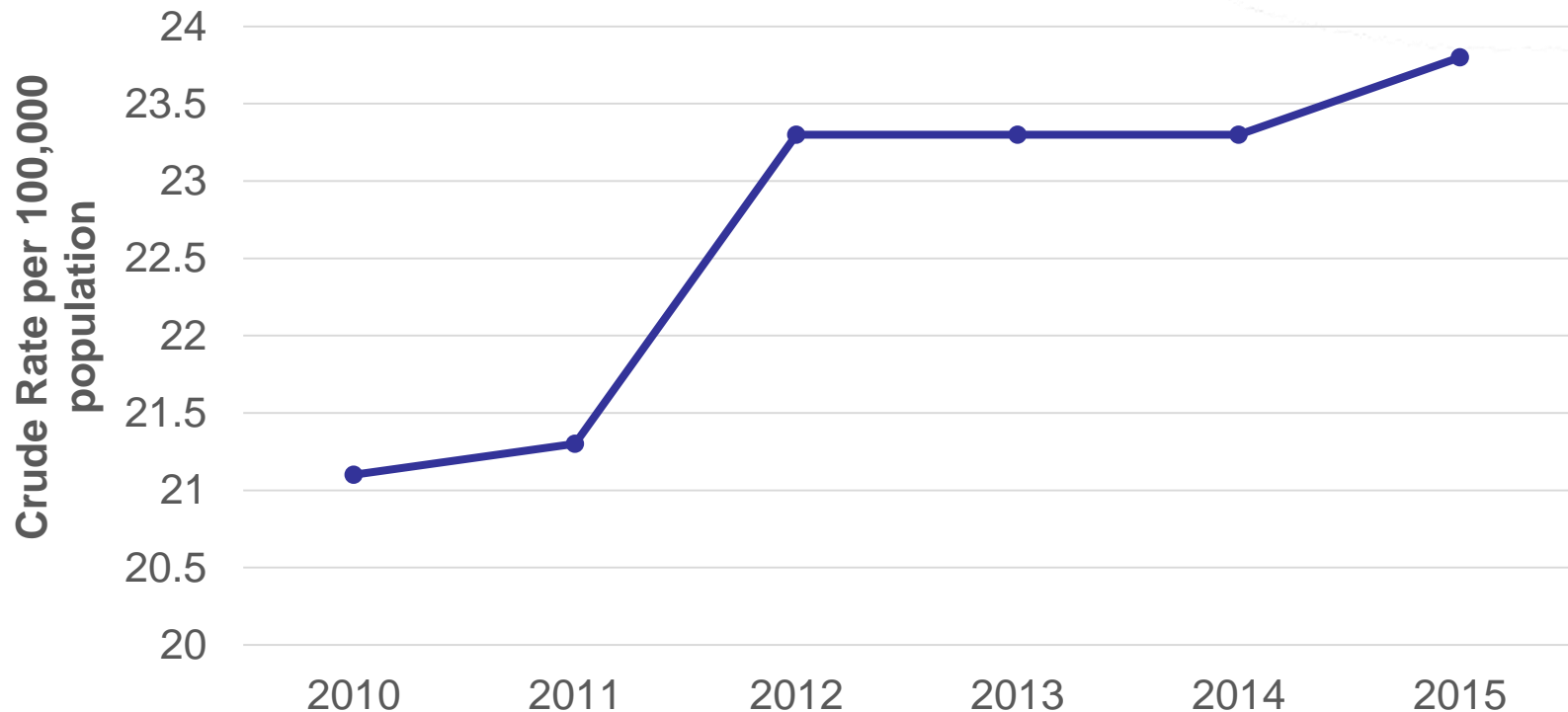

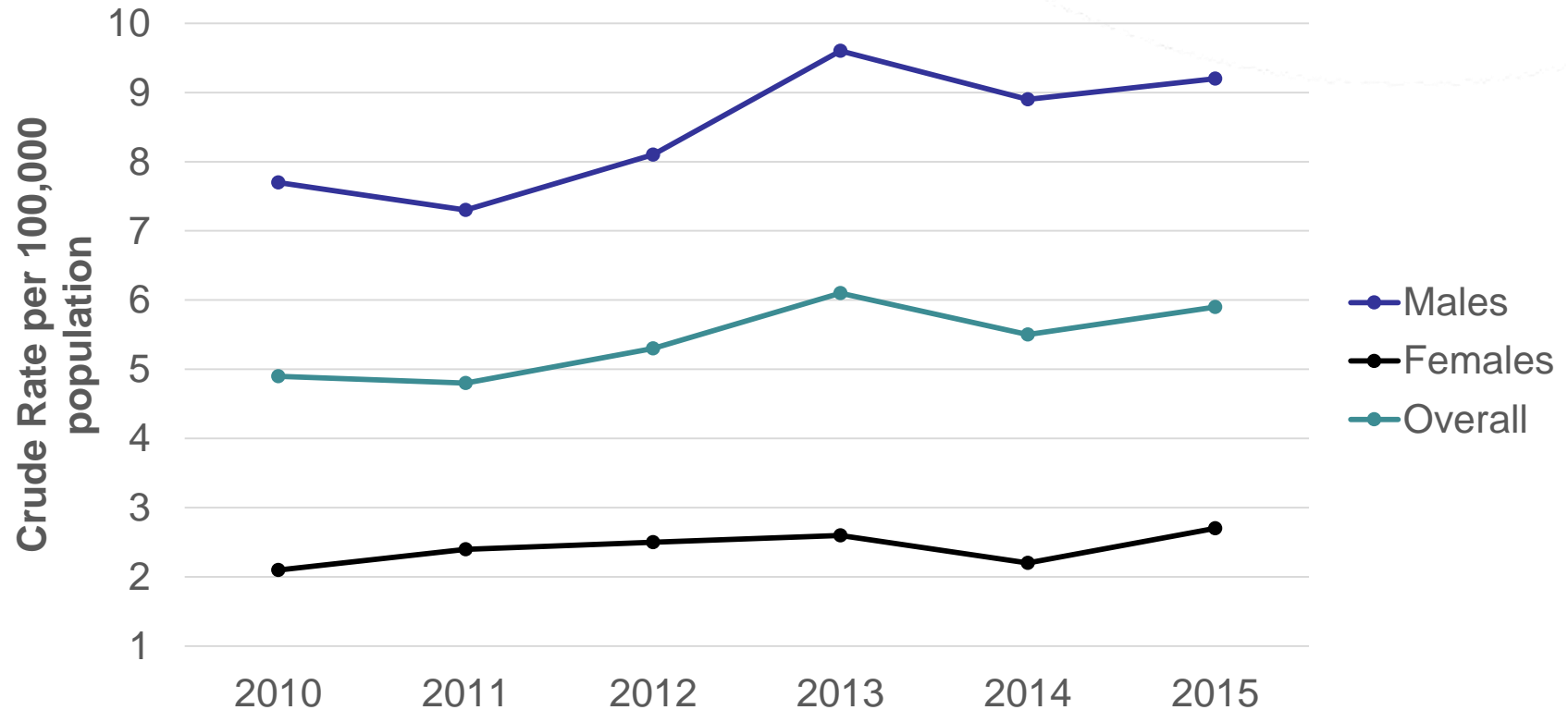

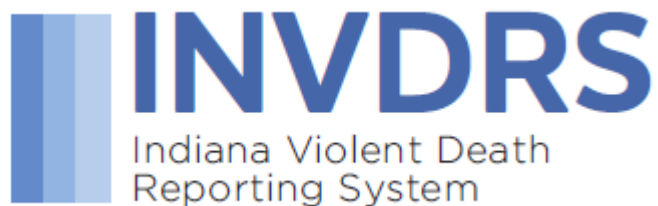


Manner of Death

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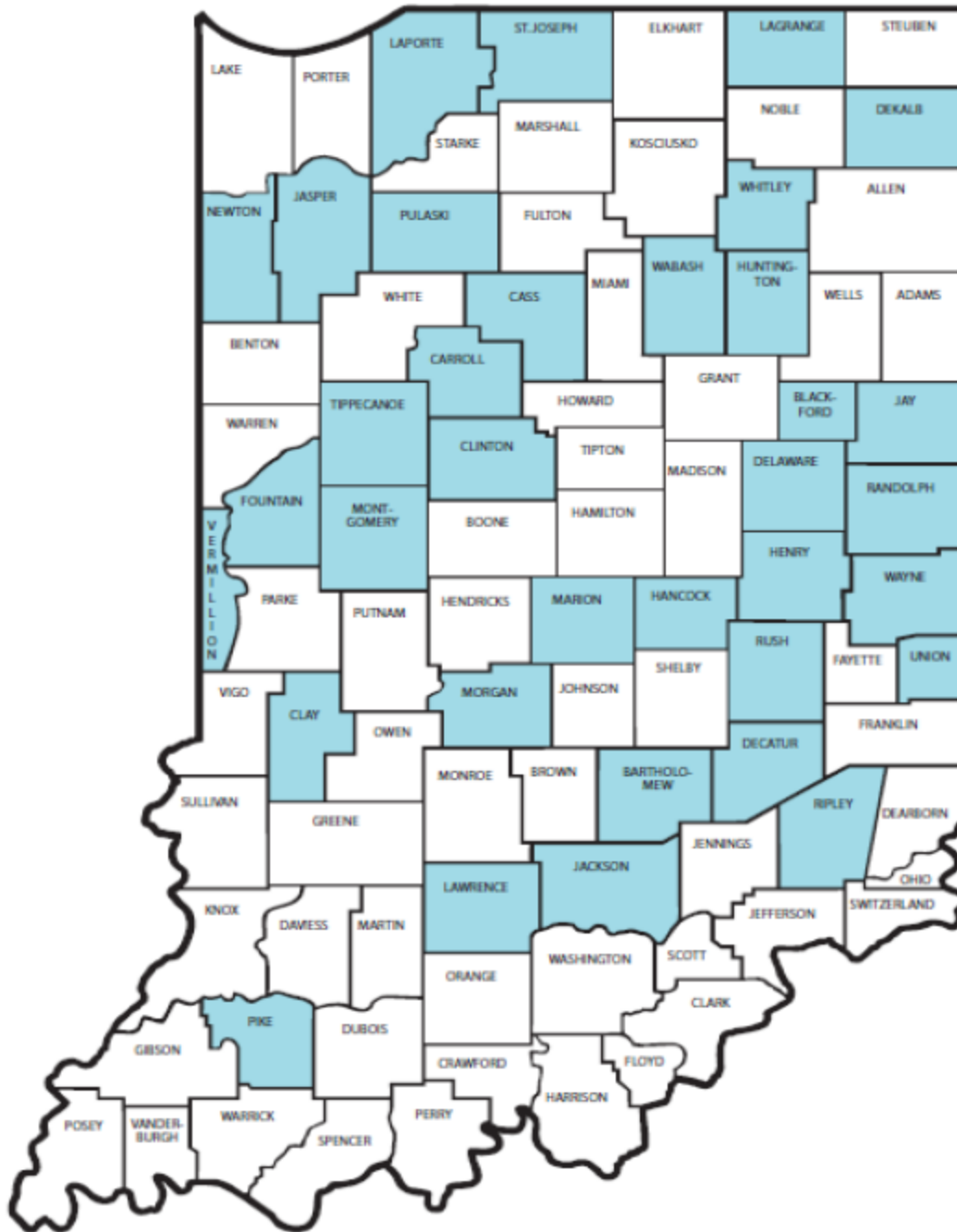

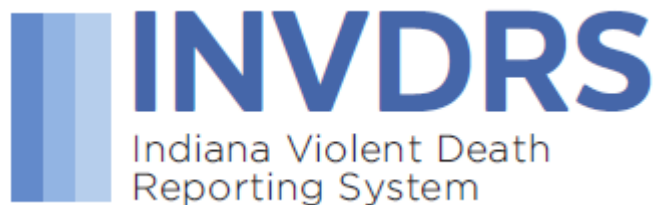

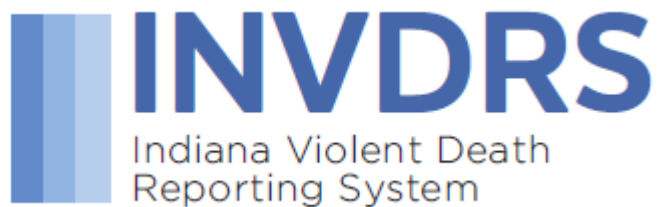

Other Data Sources



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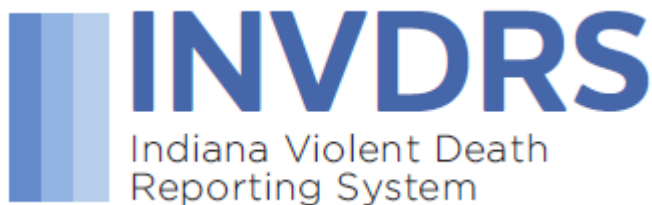
Child Fatality Review (CFR)

- Abstracted 14 CFR reports into INVDRS
- Records Abstractor will continue to use the CFR reports as they become available.



Trauma Registry

- 163 Trauma Registry reports have been included in INVDRS
- The Trauma Registry data is due quarterly and identification of INVDRS cases in this registry is done after these deadlines.



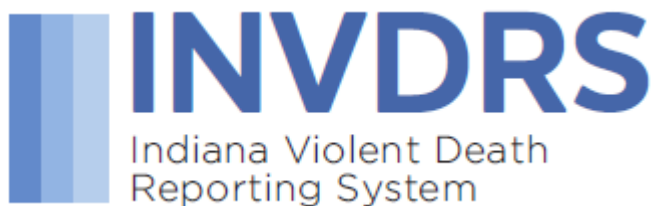

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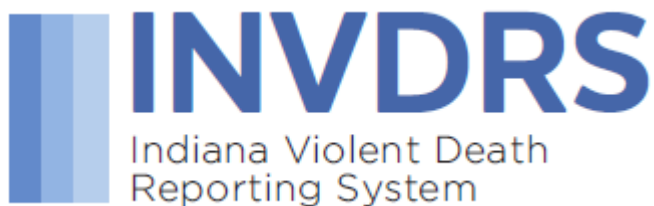


ADVISORY BOARD: MEMBERS

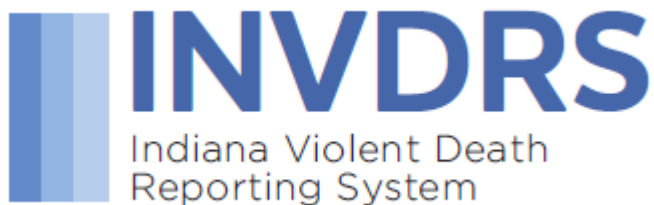

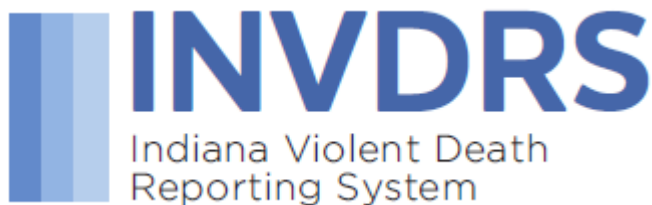

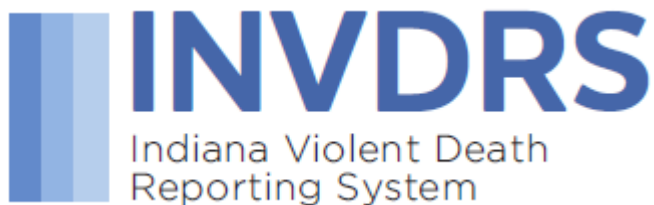
