

Key Differences Between Prior Version of TB Reporting Form and New Version

Any data captured for the new/revised questions should be included as a note under the Supplemental Information tab in NBS until NBS is updated later this year.

Overall

- Revision in layout including movement of some questions to different sections of the form

New questions

- If female, was individual pregnant at time of evaluation?
- Country of usual residence
- Lived outside of the United States of >2 months uninterrupted?
 - o This question was previously only asked for pediatric patients
- Length of treatment for individuals noted to have been previously diagnosed with TB disease
- Previous diagnosis of Latent TB Infection
 - o Year and length of treatment if previously diagnosed with LTBI
- Data on CD4 Count testing if patient is HIV-positive
- Diabetic at time of evaluation – yes/no
- Data on A1C & Fasting Blood Glucose testing if patient has diabetes
- Current smoking or vaping of nicotine products status at time of evaluation
- Additional questions about whether patient ever worked in certain occupations, was ever homeless, & was ever a resident of a correctional facility

Removed questions

- Lives within city limits yes/no
- Age
- Immigration status at first entry to the US
- Infectious period start/end dates
 - o This data will still be required to be completed under the Contact Tracing tab in NBS for infectious TB patients
- Whether drugs were requested through the Indiana Department of Health

Questions with modifications

- Race – added option for 'Other'
- Initial reason evaluated for TB disease
 - o Options have been condensed and simplified
- Additional risk factors has several new options
 - o Viral hepatitis B, Viral hepatitis C
