- The Library Development Office supports the improvement and development of library services to all Indiana citizens including:
  - INSPIRE.in.gov
  - Indiana Memory
  - Hoosier State Chronicles
  - InfoExpress
  - SRCS (Statewide Remote Circulation System)
- Includes consultants in the areas of library finance, management, planning, evaluation, grants, board training, trustees, ERate, expansion, library standards, certification, statistics, new director information, PLAC information and unserved communities
- Administers statewide library services like InfoExpress library courier service, LSTA grants, digitization projects and the Read-To-Me Project

# Professional Development Office (PDO)

- The Professional Development Office supports the advancement and development of library staff in all Indiana libraries for improved services to the citizens of Indiana
- Includes specialists in the areas of programming, children's services, continuing education opportunities and services available from the Indiana State Library including book club kits for youth, LEGO® kits, story time kits and tech kits
- Regional coordinators, with expertise in library services, are available for every library in the state
- Trainings on a variety of library related topics for staff development
- Leadership Academy through the Indiana State Library Professional Development Committee
