a. NCEES

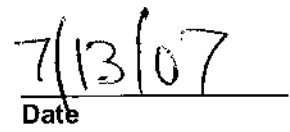
Staff presented the board with the medal from the NCEES celebrating 100 years of licensure for professional engineers.
