XIII. BOARD DIRECTOR'S REPORT

A. Legislative Update

SB 490 was vetoed by the Governor. The Memorandum was distributed to the board for their review.

B. IPLA Statistics

XIV. OLD/NEW BUSINESS

A. Proposed Amendments to Indiana Code 25-4 and Title 804 of the Indiana Administrative Code

Design Discipline Rules: Currently the statutory language says you must have 7 years of experience and a degree in design discipline. The rules define design discipline, but it needs to be changed to remove the "degree in architecture".

Fee Rules: The OMB will not process any rules which have any fee language in it. Thus those proposed changes are still in limbo.

Statutory Changes: The board wants to consider statutory changes that would give the board discretion and the ability to grant licensure if an applicant has experience without having a degree in design discipline.

B. Requirements for ARE Exam – Timing

Making any changes to this would require legislative changes. In June, NCARB will in all likelihood allow applicants to sit for the ARE once they are eligible to enroll in the IDP. NCARB will hold out two sections to be completed once the IDP is fulfilled and they are changing the exam for next year. A person can take the exam while still in school, because you can begin your IDP while still in school. The exam is also being changed from 9 parts to 7 parts; however, a person cannot take the last two parts until he has fulfilled the IDP requirements. The board will continue this discussion after the national conference, after being armed with more information. (IC 25-4-1-7)

Board Action: A motion was made to write/make changes to the statute to be in line with NCARB Resolution 07-8 which is titled Handbook and Model Law Amendment ARE timing ...the board wants to move forward drafting the language to present to the IPLA legislative team.

A motion was made to appoint Dave Rausch as the board designee to the NCARB annual conference, specifically regarding ARE timing.


