Re: Requirements for licensure/Sequencing and Comity Applications

Issue: what if we look at the applicant's qualifications at the time they apply for licensure in Indiana, not at the time they were licensed in their original state? The issue is the statutory language under Sect. 21 regarding "conflicting with Indiana requirements". We'll be looking at their experience at the time they apply to Indiana not at the time they were licensed in their first state. Based upon this, rarely would we deny a comity applicant based upon experience. The education and exam portion will be unchanged. We could do this by rule change. The board is in favor of moving ahead on this rule change under 864 IAC 1.1-5-1.
