# IV. INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (ISNAP) REPORT

Charles Lindquist, ISNAP Program Director, presented the monthly report to the Board. Mr. Lindquist informed the Board that ISNAP has, as of March, 2006, 438 active clients, 26 new intakes, 78 intakes in process and 27 RMA's returned. Mr. Lindquist informed the Board of the next provider meeting, which is April 25, 2006 at St. Joesph Hospital in Fort Wayne. Sgt. Don McCay with the Indiana State Police will be speaking on the methamphetamine culture. Mr. Lindquist stated that the ISNAP website, www.IndianaNurses.org, is almost fully completed. Mr. Lindquist spoke to the audience about the ISNAP program at the request of the Board.
