IV. INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Chuck Lindquist, ISNAP Program Director, presented the monthly report to the Board. Mr. Lindquist informed the Board that ISNAP has, as of March 1, 2011, 577 active clients, 17 new intakes, 37 intakes in process, 24 closures in monitoring and 27 new Recovery Monitoring Agreements returned.

Mr. Lindquist advised that Withim Laboratories can now screen participants for suboxone use as an additional test.

Mr. Lindquist noted that ISNAP is now closing participant files more quickly and referring to the Board as appropriate, self referrals to ISNAP are down, perhaps as a result of a more punitive approach for non-compliance.

Mr. Lindquist addressed the attendees at the Board Meeting at the request of the Board President and described the nature of the ISNAP program, which provides monitoring and assessment / treatment referral services to nurses licensed in Indiana who meet the program's monitoring criteria.

V. EDUCATION

A. Complaint regarding exit exams used by Nursing Programs

Mr. Gorman advised the Board of recent complaints from students regarding the use of exit examinations gauging likelihood of NCLEX passage before certifying completion of the program and awarding the student eligibility for licensure by examination. The concern is that schools are weeding students out after putting them through the entire nursing program in an effort to maintain good pass rates and compliance with Board accreditation requirements. Discussion by the Board members acknowledged the situation but that current regulations do not prohibit schools from this practice.

E. FYI: ITT Technical Institute, Newburgh: Sarah Seaton announced as program chair for ASN program.

F: Proposed pass rates for RN and PN programs and adjusted pass rates, school pass rate trends, annual reports. Proposed 2010 RN: 86.8%, Proposed 2010 PN: 86.1%.

Mr. Gorman presented calculated pass rates for schools regarding first time test-takers from Indiana nursing schools in 2010. Several schools were identified as having 3 or more consecutive substandard pass rate years, and each of these schools will be contacted, informed of their requirement to submit a plan of correction, and scheduled to present those plans at future Board meetings. The identified schools will be scheduled on a staggered basis to prevent an uneven schedule.

VI. DISCUSSION

A. Debra Robertson

Ms. Robertson appeared before the Board as part of her required quarterly appearance on her chronic pain management/alternative to ISNAP monitoring strategy. She had not appeared before the Board as required since late 2009. She explained that she had not kept in contact as required because the Board never sent reminders and that she had been dealing with personal issues. A motion was made and seconded to issue an Order to Show Cause to Ms. Robertson to consider her compliance with the current Board order and whether or not to modify that order.

VII. BOARD DIRECTOR REPORT

Mr. Gorman informed the Board of Regina Haight’s resignation from appointment to the Nursing Board. There are currently two vacant positions on the Board, and the Governor’s office has been made aware of the urgency of the need for the new appointments.

Board discussion occurred on how to best utilize Administrative Law Judges and who might be eligible or might be good candidates for appointments. The ALJ meeting in April was canceled due to last minute unavailability of an ALJ.




