II. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

III. ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES FROM THE JANUARY 19, 2012 MEETING OF THE BOARD

A motion was made and seconded to adopt the January 19, 2012 nursing board minutes. McIntosh/Ogle, 6-0-1, motion carries, Hall abstains

IV. INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Charles Lindquist addressed the Board. ISNAP is rolling out the second phase of the electronic records management system. The vendor will be here in April 2012 to present a demonstration to the Board. ISNAP's monthly compliance report for January 2012 indicates that 32 RMA's were returned, 18 new intakes were conducted, 8 licensees successfully completed the program and 12 licensees were closed out for non-compliance. Ms. Ogle requested that questions that she had regarding the ISNAP financials be answered in writing prior to the March 2012 board meeting.

Michael Minglin appeared on behalf of the Office of the Attorney General. The Board requested additional clarification on the "Report from the Office of the Attorney General." Specifically, Ms. Ogle would like to see a breakdown of the formulas for the year to year comparison figures. The Board also requested a status regarding the OAG's response to the PLA/Boards memo. Mr. Minglin indicated that a response is forthcoming but was unsure of the date. He indicated that he would communicate the date to Ms. Crawford as soon as possible.

VIII. PERSONAL APPEARANCES

8:45 a.m.

Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to accept the ALJ recommendations on personal appearances. McIntosh/Ogle, 5-0-0, motion carries

1. Tamatha Kirby

Ms. Kirby's personal appearance meeting was rescheduled from January 19. She appeared regarding her application for RN licensure by examination, reporting 7 failures since completing nursing school in 2002. She stated she has registered for a refresher course. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that she provide formal documentation of 95% or higher probability of passing the NCLEX and then she will be allowed to test again.

2. Stacy Tabor

Ms. Tabor appeared regarding her application for LPN licensure by examination. She gave a positive response and there was a CBC hit. She explained a public intoxication charge for minor consumption. Her CBC listed several incidents but no arrests since 2005 for driving while suspended. She states she still drinks. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that she be allowed to test and that she have an ISNAP evaluation. Her license will be issued on probation for the length of the RMA with quarterly employer reports.

3. Jordan Ellis

Mr. Ellis' personal appearance was rescheduled from Jan.5. He appeared regarding his application for RN licensure by examination. He gave a positive response and had a CBC hit. He reported a DUI in Sept. 2011 with a BAC of .17 and is on criminal probation. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that he have an ISNAP evaluation and his license be issued on probation for the length of the RMA or the criminal probation, whichever is longer.

4. Romel Turner

Mr. Turner appeared regarding his application for LPN licensure by examination. He has failed NCLEX 5 times since completing nursing school in 2002. He states test anxiety and previous personal circumstances affected those test scores. He has active CNA and HHA licenses and has taken an NCLEX review course. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended he take a review course and provide proof of 95% probability of passing and then he may test.

5. Misty Chapman

Ms. Chapman appeared regarding her application for RN licensure by examination. There was a hit on the CBC but no positive response on her application. She did not report an arrest for public intoxication in Sept. 2010. She explained that she had consumed alcohol the day before and had fallen asleep in her car. She was awakened and taken to jail where she became disoriented because her blood sugar was too low. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that she be allowed to test and have an ISNAP evaluation. Her license will be issued on probation for the length of the RMA. If not eligible, she may petition to have the probation lifted.

6. Shane Chapman

Mr. Chapman appeared regarding his application for RN licensure by examination. He gave a positive response and had CBC hits. He explained several arrests: in 1995 for possession of a handgun without a permit, in 1996 for theft and driving on a suspended license, in 2001 for theft and possession of a controlled substance, residential entry and invasion of privacy for a domestic situation. He reports no arrests since 2002. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that he be allowed to test and his license be issued free and clear.

7. Michael Jusko

Mr. Jusko appeared regarding his application for RN licensure by examination. He gave positive responses and had a CBC hit. He explained 2 public intoxication charges and an arrest for driving while intoxicated. He reported no arrests since 2003. He has held numerous employments but not in health care. He stated he still drinks occasionally but not in conjunction with driving. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that he be allowed to test and his license be issued free and clear.

8. Angela Hewitt

Ms. Hewitt appeared regarding her application for LPN licensure by examination. There was a positive response and a CBC hit. She reported a DUI in 2001 and shoplifting in 2009. These occurred before nursing school. She has an expired CNA license. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that she be allowed to test and her license be issued free and clear.

9. Glenn Alters

Mr. Alters appeared regarding his application for LPN licensure by examination. There was a positive response and a CBC hit. He explained there was a charge of stealing a vehicle in a dispute with an acquaintance and a charge of child molesting filed by his ex-wife in a contentious divorce and custody battle. These incidents were reported in Florida in 1989. ALJ Pressley and Hall recommended he be allowed to test and his license be issued free and clear.

10. Abraham Kabbany

Mr. Kabbany appeared regarding his application for LPN licensure by examination. He has failed the NCLEX three times since completing nursing school in 2002. He stated he has done an online review course offered by Kaplan. He reported personal problems during those test attempts also. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that he provide proof of 95% or higher probability of passing the NCLEX and then he may test.

11. Alton Knight, Jr.

Mr. Knight appeared regarding his application for RN licensure by examination. There was a CBC hit that he did not report on his application. He reported several incidents for failure to appear and driving while suspended in 2005-2007. He did not report these on his RN application nor on his LPN application because there was no CBC requirement in 2010. He has a CNA license also. He reports no new incidents since these matters were resolved. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that he be allowed to test and his license will be issued free and clear.

12. Madeline Enlow

Ms. Enlow appeared regarding her application for LPN licensure by endorsement. She explained a positive response and CBC hit. Incidents were related to theft, check deception, and receiving stolen property. She reports no new incidents since 2008. She is licensed in KY. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that her license be issued free and clear.

13. Nadia Tabariasl

Ms. Tabariasl appeared regarding her application for RN licensure by examination. She explained her positive response and the CBC hit related to 2 incidents of underage drinking in 2007 and a DUI in 2009 but no incidents since. These incidents occurred while she was in nursing school and resulted in her mandatorily sitting out of nursing school for 1 ½ years. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that she be allowed to test and her license be issued free and clear.

14. Elizabeth Crawford

Ms. Crawford's personal appearance will be rescheduled to the April 5 meeting.

15. Nicolle Dauphinee

Ms. Dauphinee sent documentation that she would not be attending the personal appearance. The meeting will be rescheduled one additional time.

16. Leigh Devine

Ms. Devine appeared regarding her application for RN licensure by examination. Ms. Devine explained the positive response and CBC hit on her application. She reported problems with alcohol but no drinking since 2005. She stated she was also charged with possession of paraphernalia belonging to her husband. She stated she went through drug and alcohol treatment twice. She also explained a grand larceny charge related to someone stealing her driver's license and test driving a car that was not returned. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that she have an ISNAP evaluation and sign an RMA if eligible. Her license will be issued on probation for the length of the RMA. If not eligible, the license will be issued free and clear.

17. Rachel Elliott

Ms. Elliott appeared regarding her application for RN licensure by examination. She explained her positive response and CBC hit. She reported a DUI in August 2011 with a BAC of .15. She was not ordered to be on probation and currently has a restricted driver's license. She stated this occurred while she was in nursing school and that she no longer drinks. She provided an assessment for substance abuse but this was not done by a licensed provider. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended she have an ISNAP evaluation and that her license be issued on probation for the length of the RMA if eligible. If not eligible, the license will be issued free and clear.

18. Rachel Walsh

Ms. Walsh appeared regarding her application for RN licensure by examination. She has failed the NCLEX 4 times since completing nursing school in 2009. She stated she most recently took the exam in Sept. 2011 after taking the Kaplan

review course in August 2011 but failed on that attempt. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that the matter be referred to the full board for continued review. She stated that she is continuing to study and has taken the review course 3 times. The BON recommended that her application be denied and she may reapply with proof of 95% or higher probability of passing the NCLEX. It was suggested she may want to seek a professional assessment for test anxiety or learning disability.

19. Brian Dizon

Mr. Dizon appeared regarding his application for RN licensure by examination. He has failed the NCLEX 15 times since completing nursing school in 1998. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that he complete a review course and provide proof of 95% or higher probability of passing the test. It was suggested he may want to address issue of test anxiety. He does not work in health care but needs health care experience.

20. Laura Schipp

Ms. Schipp appeared regarding her application for RN licensure application by examination. She has failed the NCLEX 3 times since completing nursing school in 2007. She reported she completed the Hurst review course in May 2011. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended she provide proof of 95% or higher probability of passing the NCLEX. She may also need to address test anxiety.

21. Tracy Alderton

Ms. Alderton's personal appearance for renewal of her RN licensure will be rescheduled one more time.

22. Deborah Skaggs

Her personal appearance was rescheduled from Jan. 19. Her license is expired. Since she explained her positive response, litigation has been filed by the AG's office for presentation during the Feb. 16 board meeting.

23. Tiffany Morrison

Ms. Morrison's personal appearance was rescheduled from Jan. 19. She appeared regarding the positive response on her RN renewal application. She reported a termination due to violating facility networking policy. She is currently working in Florida. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended her license be renewed with proof of completion of 12 CEs in HIPAA and 12 CEs in professionalism/ethics.

24. Amanda Martinez

Ms. Martinez appeared regarding the positive response on her RN renewal. She reported a DUI in Jan. 2010. ISNAP closed her file in March 2010 for non-compliance. She stated she has not been working as a nurse. She is on probation until October 2012. She also reported a DUI in 2006. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended referring the matter to the AG's office due to the ISNAP closure.

25. Norma Spaulding

Ms. Spaulding's personal appearance was rescheduled from Jan. 19. Her license is expired and she appeared regarding the positive response on her renewal. She reported an arrest in August 2010 for driving while impaired. She had hydrocone in her possession. She was referred to ISNAP but did not enter monitoring due to being on pain medication. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended referring the matter to the AG's office due to the ISNAP memo.

26. Elizabeth Sciscoe

Ms. Sciscoe's personal appearance was rescheduled from Jan. 19. She did not appear as requested and the personal appearance will be rescheduled one additional time.

27. Vickie Yaggi

Ms. Yaggi did not appear as requested regarding the positive response on her RN renewal. Her meeting will be rescheduled one additional time.

28. Michelle Schilling

Ms. Schilling appeared regarding the positive response on her RN renewal. She appeared before the ALJ on Jan. 19 and reported numerous issues. She admits to having alcohol dependence. The ALJ recommended that her personal appearance be continued until the full board meeting on Feb. 16. She is compliant with ISNAP. She stated her AZ license is not suspended because she voluntarily surrendered it. She stated she is dealing with addiction issues and 9/11/11 is her date of sobriety. She appeared with counsel and her employer. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that her license be renewed.

29. Shari Brindley

Ms. Brindley did not appear regarding the positive response on her RN renewal. She requested the meeting be rescheduled. It will be rescheduled one additional time.

30. Michael Turner

Mr. Turner appeared regarding the positive response on his RN renewal. He reported a DUI in 2006 and another in 2008. His license has been expired since 2003. He completed probation in January 2012. He has a diagnosis of alcohol abuse in remission. His IL license is active. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended that his license be renewed.

31. Karen DeCocker-Geist

Ms. DeCocker-Geist appeared at the BON's request after an employer reported she was terminated and she did not report it on her renewal. Ms. DeCocker-Geist stated she was not terminated; she resigned. She brought documentation regarding her employment history. It appears to be an administrative issue, not a practice issue due to a communication misunderstanding. ALJ Presley and Hall recommended her license be renewed.

32. Mitos Tan

Ms. Tan appeared in front of the full board regarding her renewal application. She practiced as a nurse in Illinois but has not actively practiced nursing since 1993. A motion was made and seconded to renew the license on probation for the sole purpose of taking a refresher course with a clinical component. Ms. Tan may not practice as a nurse until the refresher course is completed. Burghduff/Laux, 5-0-0, motion carries

33. Kathleen Dull

Ms. Dull appeared in front of the full Board regarding her positive response. She was terminated from positions in the 2007, 2009 and 2011 renewal cycles. A motion was made and seconded to place the license on indefinite probation, must have one year of active nursing practice, employer reports and MMPI-2. Burghduff/McIntosh, 5-0-0, motion carries.

34. Loretta Terry

Ms. Terry appeared in front of the full Board regarding her positive response. Her license expired in 2010. She reported an incarceration in 2010 for driving on a suspended license and a prior DUI. A motion was made and seconded to renew the license on probation for the length of an ISNAP RMA or criminal probation, whichever is longer with employer reports. 


