II. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

III. ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES FROM THE MAY 17, 2012 MEETING OF THE BOARD

A motion was made and seconded to adopt the minutes of the May 17, 2012 meeting. Narwold/Dolk, 6-0-0, motion carries

IV. INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Chuck Lindquist presented on behalf of ISNAP and presented the Board with handouts for the May 2012 report and the quarterly report for the first quarter of 2012. Mr. Lindquist noted that approximately 46% of clients are regulatory at this point up from 15-20% at the beginning of the ISNAP contract.

**F. Brown Mackie Merrillville-Request to Close PN Program /Transition Plan**

Staff from Brown Mackie was present. They have seven students remaining in their PN program who are on track to graduate in calendar year 2012. Staff indicated that students will have ongoing support to obtain records, career counseling, etc. once the nursing program closes as the campus itself will remain open. The program chair and one faculty member will remain until all students have graduated. The Board requested information as to whether there is a contingency plan if one of these students does not graduate in this calendar year. Staff indicated they will offer classes again if needed until the students successfully complete the PN program.

**Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to accept the plan. Narwold/Laux, 6-0-0, motion carries**

**G. Ancilla College Site Visit Re: Conditional Accreditation-Lynda/Karen**

NCLEX Scores: 2007: 62.96% 2008: 56.3% 2009: 80.46% 2010: 74.1% 2011: 70.59% (24/34 passed)

Staff from Ancilla College was present. Ms. Narwold indicated that the site visit was completed due to low test scores since the inception of the program. The facility is an older facility and there are some space issues that are being addressed. One concern was faculty as they have good clinical faculty and teaching has been an issue. They are working on faculty development plan for examination writing. One issue addressed was admission standards as the mission of the school indicates a lower admission standard. They are using HESI at this time. The recommendation is conditional accreditation until pass rates are up. The school requested a proposed a timeframe out to 2015 to make improvements. Another issue brought to the site visitors' attention is that the school has signed an agreement with Purdue North Central to take on their RN to BSN program. Ms. Narwold expressed concerns about taking resources away from the current program as Ms. Fitzgerald is named as the coordinator for the new program. Ms. Fitzgerald expressed difficulty in actually finding the source of the problem for their low NCLEX scores and indicated they are using some evidence-based practice tools. Ms. Fitzgerald indicated that in other places things they have implemented have been successful but are not successful at Ancilla. Ms. Laux asked what has been done in regards to exams for students and how that coordinates with HESI. Ms. Fitzgerald indicated that exams instructors create correlate well with HESI exit exams. Ancilla staff agreed that the problem still is that these students still cannot pass the NCLEX at the national level. Ancilla has been doing HESI since 2008. The Board asked if the competition for clinical sites would be encumbered by the new Purdue North Central program. Ms. Fitzgerald indicated that was up to Purdue North Central and she assumed the Purdue North Central students would be competing for the same clinical sites.

**Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to continue on conditional accreditation for an additional 18 months until December 2013. Narwold/Laux, 6-0-0, motion carries**

**H. University of St. Francis Site Visit Re: Full Accreditation for ASN Program-Lynda/Karen**

NCLEX Scores: 2009: 100% 2010: 100% 2011: 81.25%

Staff from USF was present. Ms. Dolk indicated that the visit was delightful. The new facility is very spacious and more than adequate for the program's needs. They appreciated the collaboration and mentoring with faculty and with curriculum with USF Fort Wayne. The students and faculty are all happy with the program. The IT support is lacking at this point in time and USF is working on that piece. As they grow, the program may need additional space for students. The Board discussed two faculty members whose highest degree is ASN. The staff indicated that the two RN's who are working on RN to MSN transition will both graduate in 2014. They have already completed the BSN requirements but are not awarded a diploma until the end of the program. The recommendation is full accreditation.

**Board Action: A motion was made and seconded for full accreditation. Laux/McIntosh, 6-0-0, motion carries**

**I. Ivy Tech Madison Region: Request for expansion of ASN Program to Lawrenceburg campus**

Staff from Ivy Tech appeared. They would like permission to extend their transition program to Lawrenceburg. The expansion will be less than 10 students per admission. The last site visit from NLNAC was at this campus. They already offer the ASN program. **Board**

**Action: A motion was made and seconded that the region does not need to apply for a new program. Laux/ Narwold, 6-0-0, motion carries**

**1. Kelia Brown LPN Examination 6 failures; completed school in 2003 (Previously Scheduled)**

Ms. Brown appeared regarding her application for licensure by exam. She has failed the NCLEX 6 times and graduated in 2003. She is currently working as a home health aide. She had a personal tutor in the past. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to put her into a review course with a 95% probability that she can pass NCLEX. McIntosh/Burghduff, 5-0-0, motion carries

**2. Kathryn Price LPN Examination Completed school in 2007 (Previously Scheduled)**

Ms. Price failed to attend and has been previously rescheduled. A motion was made and seconded to deny the application. McIntosh/Narwold, 6-0-0, motion carries

**3. Sylvie Bogne LPN Examination Positive Response, CBC Hit (Previously Scheduled)**

Ms. Bogne failed to attend and has been previously rescheduled. A motion was made and seconded to deny the application. McIntosh/Laux 6-0-0, motion carries

**4. Sammie Tate RN Examination failures; completed school in 1996 (Previously Scheduled)**

Ms. Tate failed to attend and has been previously rescheduled. A motion was made and seconded to deny the application. McIntosh/Laux denied 5-0-0

**5. Tangie Wilson LPN Endorsement Positive Response; CBC Hit (Previously Scheduled)**

Ms. Wilson failed to attend. A motion was made and seconded to deny the application. McIntosh/Laux 5-0-0, motion carries

**6. Elizabeth Hurtado LPN Endorsement CBC Hit**

Ms. Hurtado appeared in person regarding her application for licensure by endorsement. She has a battery conviction from 1994, arrested in 1994 for criminal conversion, arrested in 1998 for criminal conversion and criminal mischief and again arrested in 1998 for public intoxication. She still drinks occasionally defined by her as special events, twice a month. She has attended anger management classes in the past. She reports that her Kansas license is active has been practicing since January 2010 with no terminations. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to issue free and clear. Narwold/Burghduff, 5-0-0, motion carries

**7. Kathleen Housty RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Housty appeared regarding her application by examination. She indicated that she was arrested in 2009 due to marijuana in her home that she says belonged to her son and she was unaware of it. Her son was not present in the home. She knows two bags were found but she does not understand the amount. Mr. Burghduff indicated the notation indicates "dealing" vs. "possession" and she is not sure why that is the case. She is not sure why the police came to her home but she believes it was in relation to her son's activities. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to allow her to test and issue free and clear. McIntosh/Laux, 5-0-0, motion carries

**8. Vanessa Lewis LPN Examination Positive Response**

Ms. Lewis appeared regarding her application by examination. She has been terminated from several facilities. At least one write up involved failure to report a fall. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to allow her to test and issue free and clear. McIntosh/Burghduff, 6-0-0, motion carries

**9. Anna Burton RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Burton appeared with counsel Anthony Spahr. She reported two Class D felonies which are now in a criminal diversion agreement as of April 4, 2012 which will last for one year. The underlying incident has to do with alleged theft of medication from the correctional facility where she worked. She admits that silvadene cream was taken from her former employer but that a dose of Keflex came from a veterinarian for her animal. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to allow her to test and issue on probation once she passes the NCLEX with monthly employer reports and 6 months active nursing practice prior to withdrawal. Burghduff/Laux, 6-0-0, motion carries

**10. Gabriela Ziebold RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Ziebold appeared in person regarding her application by examination. She reported an OWI in October 2011. She was pulled over for not stopping at a stop sign. Her BAC was approximately .14 or .15. Board Action: A motion was made to go to ISNAP for an evaluation and sign an RMA if eligible. She will be allowed to test and issued free and clear. Burghduff/Laux, 5-0-0, motion carries

**11. Ronald Robertson RN Endorsement CBC Hit**

Mr. Robertson appeared regarding his application by endorsement. He reported a long history of marijuana use since 1980. He was using as recent as five years ago but reports being clean since May 2007. He does report using alcohol as a substitute for marijuana but

is now actively working the steps. He only had an LPN and RN license in Utah. He surrendered his license in Utah. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to deny the request. McIntosh/Laux, 5-0-0, motion carries

**12. Erika Martin RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Martin appeared regarding her application by examination. She reported two previous charges. The first is a conversion charge from 2009 which was subject to a pre-trial diversion. In July 2011 she had a DUI with conditional deferment. She had an interlock device on her car from September 2011 to February 2012. That case was dismissed as of 5/31/12. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to issue the license on probation with 6 months compliance in an ISNAP RMA. If not an ISNAP candidate, may petition to lift probation immediately. Burghduff/McIntosh, 6-0-0, motion carries

**13. Wanda Hawkins RN Endorsement CBC Hit**

Ms. Hawkins appeared regarding her application by endorsement. She reported current licensure in Georgia. She was placed on criminal probation in 2009 for appointing a homeless person as a secretary in her business there who attempted to apply for a credit card with personal information. The homeless person was not charged but Ms. Hawkins was charged because she was the organization co-founder. She is on criminal probation until 2019. She also two arrests for theft in 1975 and an arrest for theft by check in 1983. She also had a battery charge in 1996 she indicates was an altercation with a sister-in-law. Her license in Georgia is active. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to deny licensure. Laux/Narwold, 5-0-0, motion carries

**14. Amanda Engle RN Examination 6 failures; completed school in 2009**

Ms. Engle appeared regarding her application by examination. She has failed the NCLEX 6 times. She reports that she is getting ready to start an ATI comprehensive review and is studying Kaplan. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded that she obtain a review course with a 95% probability of passing the exam then she can test. McIntosh/Narwold, 5-0-0, motion carries

**15. Vanessa Rockett LPN Examination completed school in 2003**

Ms. Rockett failed to appear. She will be rescheduled one time. McIntosh/Laux 5-0-0, motion carries

**16. Erin Cummings RN Examination 3 failures, completed school in 2010**

Ms. Cummings appeared regarding her application by exam. She has failed the NCLEX 3 times. She reports that she took the NCSBN learning extension online. The last program she took was 3 weeks. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to allow her to test as the NCSBN courses averaged a 95% probability of passing the NCLEX. McIntosh/Laux, 5-0-0, motion carries

**17. Whitney Davis LPN Endorsement CBC Hit**

Ms. Davis appeared regarding her application by endorsement. She moved here from Idaho. She received a DUI in January resulting in a withheld judgment. There are no issues with her Idaho license. Allow endorsement.

**18. Rebecca Barger RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Barger appeared regarding her application by exam. In 2010 received OWI which was lowered to reckless driving. She would not meet criteria for ISNAP. She is allowed to test and if pass license to be issued free and clear.

**19. Tessa Chambers RN Examination Positive Response**

Ms. Chambers appeared regarding her application by exam. She had 2 illegal possessions of alcohol when she was under age. She received one in 2007 and the other in 2008. Allow to test and if pass license to be issued free and clear.

**20. Amelia Emerick RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Emerick appeared regarding her application by exam. She was arrested in March 2011 for a DUI. She has completed her probation. She graduated nursing school in May 2012. She has a minor consumption on her juvenile record from when she was 17. She does not meet ISNAP criteria. She is allowed to test and if pass license to be issued free and clear.

**21. Lacey Grubbs RN Examination Personal Response**

Ms. Grubbs appeared in Person for her personal appearance. In March 2010, she stole merchandise from Greenwood mall and was charged with criminal conversion. She did community service and took classes. The charges were dropped. She is allow to test and if pass license to be issued free and clear.

**22. Allison Conroy RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Conroy appeared regarding her application for exam. In October 2011, police found drugs in her house; it was not hers but was the boyfriend's at the time. She was offered a diversion and accepted. As part of the diversion she did not admit any guilt. She has completed community service and in March 2013 the arrest is to come off her record. She does not meet ISNAP Criteria. She is allow to test and if pass license to be issued free and clear.

**23. Farah Gard RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Gard appeared regarding her application for exam. She had a warrant out for arrest for Battery in 2011. When she made aware of the warrant she turned herself in. She had an altercation with ex-husband, which lead to the warrant. There was no type of charges. She is allowed to test and if passes license to be issued free and clear.

**24. Mandie Henderson RN Examination 1 failure; completed school in 2009**

Ms. Henderson appeared regarding her application for exam. She hit the 3 year mark for the graduation date. She took test once and failed. She had 2 driving while suspended in 2010 and a theft charge that was dropped. The theft charge happened when she was working at a restaurant where the register came up short, everyone working that shift was charged, a public defender told her it was easier to plead guilty. She has worked as a LPN for 6 years. She is allowed to test and if pass licensed to be issued free and clear.

**25. Julia Stickford RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Stickford appeared regarding her application by exam. She was arrested in 2008 for an OWI. Her license was suspend for 90 days, community service, probation, attended classes. In 2006 she had minor consumption charge. She is allow to test and if pass license to be issued free and clear.

**26. Sarah Knight RN Examination 4 failures; completed school in 2010**

Ms. Knight appeared in person for her personal appearance. She is to take a review course and show documentation showing a 95% or greater chance of passing statement, then will be allowed to test. Once she passes license is to be issued free and clear.

**27. Heather Anthony RN Examination 4 failures; completed school in 2010**

Ms. Anthony appeared regarding her application for exam. She took the Kaplan review and received 95% but took the test again in March and failed. She has had numerous family emergencies prior to test and believes that could be the reason for failing. She must retake review course and show documentation showing a 95% or greater chance of passing statement, then will be allowed to test. Once she passes license is to be issued free and clear.

**28. Emma Hagedorn RN Examination Positive Response**

Ms. Hagedorn appeared regarding her application for exam. She had 2 charges of minor consumption of alcohol in 2008 and another one in 2010. All cases were dismissed after attending classes and counseling. The school is aware of all 3 incidents. She will need to be evaluated by ISNAP to determine if she meets their criteria. She is allowed to test, if meets ISNAP criteria license will be issued on probation status the length of RMA, if not eligible will get license free and clear

**29. Kelly Cummings RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Cummings was present with her counsel, Lorie Brown, regarding her application by exam. In 2010 she was pulled over for drinking and driving. She contacted ISNAP on May 8<sup>th</sup>. She does not meet criteria for monitoring. She has completed criminal probation. She is allowed to test and if passes be issued a license free and clear.

**30. Lisa Poynter LPN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Poynter appeared regarding her application by exam. In 2011, she was arrested for an OWI. She plead guilty and is currently on probation. She is due to be released June 29<sup>th</sup>. She currently works as a CNA. She is allowed to test, if probation is completed after she passes her test her license can be issued free and clear. If she is still on probation then her licenses is to be issued on probation, the length of her criminal probation.

**31. Adam Ramer RN Examination CBC Hit**

Mr. Ramer appeared regarding his application by exam. In 2002, he failed drug test, 2004 received OWI, 30 days later received another OWI and involved in an accident. In 2007 he received a driving while suspended charge which was dismissed since license was actually valid. He had drug screens through IVY Tech. He needs an ISNAP assessment. He is allowed to test; license needs to be issued on probation for 6 months or length of RMA, whichever is longer.

**32. Brittany Getches RN Examination Positive Response**

Ms. Getches appeared regarding her application by exam. In 2009 took a drink from someone she didn't know, next thing woke up in jail. She was charged and plead guilty to minor consumption. There have been no issues since 2009. She is allowed to test and if passes license to be issued free and clear.

**33. Brooke Hartkorn RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Hartkorn appeared regarding her application by exam. In 2008, she was arrested for minor consumption. She completed pretrial diversion, completed drug and alcohol classes. She probably drinks 4 drinks a week but doesn't drink and drive. She is allowed to test and if passes license to issue free and clear.

**34. Amy Schenetzke RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Schenetzke appeared her application by exam. She was smoking marijuana, was growing it because she was didn't want to buy it from dealers, and she ended up selling it. She has been clean for 2 years in May. She completed 18 months of drug court. She has no other issues with other drugs besides marijuana or alcohol. She pled guilty to charges of public nuisance and drug paraphernalia. The

charges were dismissed after completion of drug court. These charges took place in 2010. She is allowed to test. She needs an evaluation with ISNAP. Her license will be issued on Probation at least a year or the length of RMA, whichever is longer.

**35. Patrick Lambert RN Examination CBC Hit**

Mr. Lambert appeared regarding his application by exam. He received a felony possession/DUI, and resisting law enforcement charges in December 2003. He completed 3 years of rehab (rehab in lieu of sentencing). During the 3 years he was arrested of 2 more DUIs. With the other 2 DUIs there were resisting law enforcement charges as well. He has been sober since March 16, 2009. He needs to have a current evaluation from ISNAP. He is allowed to test but license will be issued on probation for the length of an RMA.

**36. Kara Theil RN Examination CBC Hit**

Ms. Theil appeared in for her personal appearance. In 2011, she was arrested for an OWI. She is currently on non reporting probation until October 2012. She needs to be evaluated by ISNAP. She is allowed to test but license will be issued on Probation until criminal probation is completed or length of RMA, whichever is longer.

**37. Deana Faris RN Examination Positive Response**

Ms. Faris appeared for her personal appearance. In 1991 she had an illegal consumption charge. In 2002 she had 2 DUIs. In 2011 she had a public intoxication charge. The 2011 charge resulted in 6 months informal probation. She contacted ISNAP May 2012 and has had an assessment. She attends AA and ALON meetings. She will enter into an RMA. She is allowed to test and her license will be issued on probation status the length of RMA.

Ms. Cranford did not appear for her personal appearance. Her renewal request has been denied.

3. Amy Durisin RN Renewal Positive Response

She worked on an expired license from October 2011 to April 2012. She worked at Carmel Health and Living during this time. She is not working at this time. She was also terminated from an employer in April 2012 for personnel issues. Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to make the licensee valid to practice and refer the matter to the Office of the Attorney General for investigation. 
