#### IV. INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (ISNAP) REPORT

Ms. Little was not present.

Charles Lindquist, ISNAP Program Director, presented the monthly report to the Board. Mr. Lindquist spoke to the audience about the ISNAP program at the request of the Board. Mr. Lindquist informed the Board that ISNAP has, as of February, 2006, 422 active clients, 23 new intakes, 90 intakes in process and 26 RMA's returned. Mr. Lindquist informed the Board that ISNAP has scheduled a quarterly provider meeting on April 25, 2006 at St. Joseph Hospital, Fort Wayne, Mr. Lindquist also informed the Board that planning sessions continue for a Conference for Nurses, EAP's, and HR's sponsored by ISNAP on "Health Care Professionals -Impairment and Recovery." The conference is scheduled for September 29, 2006. Mr. Lindquist stated that this will be a "Fund Raiser" to raise funds for ISNAP's "scholarship fund" to assist with payment for urine drug screens. ISNAP is in the process of seeking sponsors, exhibitors, speakers, etc.

Ernie Klein, ISNA Executive Director, addressed the Board regarding the NCSBN Vision Paper. Mr. Klein suggested that the Board convene a Sub-Committee to vote or act on NCSBN's future regulation of APN's and to discuss some possible provisions in this document.

A motion was made and seconded to form a Sub-Committee.
