II. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

A motion was made and seconded to adopt the agenda as amended. Laux/Burghduff, 8-0-0, motion carries

III. ADOPTION OF THE MINUTES FROM THE APRIL 19, 2012 MEETING OF THE BOARD

A motion was made and seconded to adopt the April 19, 2012 nursing board minutes. McIntosh/Laux, 8-0-0, motion carries

IV. INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Chuck Lindquist reported for the Indiana State Nurses Assistance Program. ISNAP is working with the BON on contract renegotiations and is working on adding training modules for general orientation to ISNAP and training for worksite monitors. The most current copy of the newsletter was received and is being distributed to ISNAP participants electronically through AOS.

V. EDUCATION

A. Purdue North Central ASN Program: Request for Suspending ASN Program and Request for Curriculum Change (Mario Ortiz, Nursing Chair)

Dr. Mario Ortiz appeared for Purdue North Central ("PNC"). PNC is phasing out their ASN program at this time due to the requirements within the Purdue system to move ASN programs to Ivy Tech. Their last cohort has 14 students in it with a plan to graduate all of them by December 2012. **Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to accept request for suspension of the ASN Program. Narwold/Laux, 8-0-0, motion carries**

PNC is also requesting a curriculum change for the BSN program based on legislation to reduce to 120 hours from 124 hours. They took away one elective and decreased community health hours by moving leadership out from a 6 hour to a 5

hour course. They have spread out foundations to 2 semesters and moved psych to the next semester. Ms. Laux asked why they reduced core nursing hours instead of an elective. Dr. Ortiz felt leadership was embedded in multiple courses throughout the curriculum and they have retained the leadership course with getting rid of the clinical portion. Ms. Narwold asked if they are expanding their RN to BSN program and Dr. Ortiz indicated they are as they see a need in Starke and Marshall counties for this. Ancilla will be the host site for this change but the students will not be Ancilla students they will be PNC students.

Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to accept the curriculum changes. Narwold/McIntosh, 8-0-0, motion carries

B. Ivy Tech Madison and Lawrenceburg: Follow Up Report for NCLEX Improvement Plan (Georgia Smith, Dean) Laurie Peters and Georgia Smith appeared for Ivy Tech. Their first quarter NCLEX pass rate is 87.9% this year. They have increased faculty support at Lawrenceburg. They have retained 95% of their cohort at the Madison campus. The college continues to pay for Kaplan reviews for students. Ms. Laux asked about paying for Kaplan vs. ATI. Staff indicated Kaplan is more geared towards staff strategies and this is why they utilize both. They have 2 advisors dedicated now to advising pre-nursing students reducing nursing faculty time to focus on students in the nursing program. Students have developed a test taking strategies guide which is being utilized. Ms. Laux asked if students were held back if they cannot pass dosage calculation tests. If they fail the test they must repeat the course. Students have 3 attempts to pass the exam but they can repeat the course 2 times total. Ms. Laux asked about the pharmacology revisions statewide.

Board Action: A motion was made and seconded to take the school off of a corrective action plan. McIntosh/Laux, 7-0-1, Dolk abstains

D. Brown Mackie Merrillville LPN Program: Request to Close LPN Program
2011 NCLEX: 72.81% (83/114 first time test takers passed) First Quarter 2012: 66.67% (2/3 first time test takers passed)
Staff was present from Brown Mackie Merrillville requesting a closure of the LPN Program. The December cohort was the last cohort admitted under the open enrollment policy. They have 9 students remaining in their program. Two will complete studies in May 2012 and all are set to graduate by the end of 2012. The Board requested a detailed transition plan by June 11, 2012 and that the staff appear at the June 21, 2012 board meeting.

E. Kaplan College, Indianapolis PN Program: Request for Admission Criteria Change and Student Handbook Change (Jill Buchholz, RN, MSN Director)

Staff was present from Kaplan College. Board members voiced no questions on proposed admission changes.

VII. BOARD DIRECTOR REPORT

Ms. Kiefner Crawford reported that the new graduate application process is going well. Representatives from the BON and ISNAP are working on contract negotiations for the final year of the impaired nursing contract. The contract will be put out for RFP next year. In the fall, Ms. Kiefner Crawford will be traveling to two separate regions (Evansville and Valparaiso) and speaking to faculty and schools in the area regarding the Board's processes and functions. Deputy Attorney General Jason Gross appeared on behalf of the State of Indiana. Petitioner appeared in person and waived the right to counsel. Petitioner was sworn in as a witness. After a hearing, ALJ Slagle recommended that the probationary status of Ms. Springer's license not be withdrawn at this time.

The following personal appearances took place on May 3, 2012 before ALJ Jerry Burghduff:

- 1. Lynn Finch RN Endorsement CBC; answered no to all questions**
Ms. Finch appeared for her personal appearance. She stole flea medicine from store, not sure why other than upset about losing a litter of kittens and did not want to lose any more. She received 3 months of probation from court. Board recommended putting her on probation for one year, with quarterly reports and can return after a year to have it lifted.
- 2. Jennifer Matney RN Examination 3 Exam Failures**
Ms. Matney did not appear for her personal appearance.
- 3. Michael Rogers RN Examination 4 Exam Failures**
Mr. Rogers appeared for his personal appearance. He took test 4 times and failed. After the 4th time he took review course and received 95% passing. He also met with a tutor who said his text anxiety was under control. He is allowed to test.
- 4. Melinda Nolen RN Examination 6 Exam Failures**
Ms. Nolen appeared for her personal appearance. She has text anxiety. She has completed NCLEX Review with a 95% passing and has had a tutor and took Kaplan. Application Denied
- 5. Michael Grace RN Endorsement Positive Response**
Mr. Grace appeared for his personal appearance. He was terminated from employment due to medication error. He took drug screen which came back negative. Ky Board has him free to practice pending review. He stated he got distracted and forgot to chart the medications. Grant for endorsement and refer to AG's office. Should KY put on suspension or probation Indiana will follow.
- 6. Christy Naylor RN Examination 4 Exam Failures**
Ms. Naylor appeared for her personal appearance. Her son has been ill and at Riley so she was not able to study for the test. She is scheduled to begin the 6 month review at Kaplan in August- Denied to test.
- 7. Laci Dodson RN Examination 3 Exam Failures**

Ms. Dodson appeared for her personal appearance. She already took Kaplan course but did not have 95% documents in file, only receipt. ALJ was tabled until she gets the correct document. Once the documents are received we will reset personal appearance.


8. Gina Kulakowski LPN Examination CBC hit

Ms. Kulakowski appeared for her personal appearance. She received an OWI after her boss giving out shots for birthday and was pulled over on the way home (2009). Another incident she had a fight with her daughter and left house and was arrested for reckless driving. His license can be renewed on probation which is to mirror the probation Illinois has set up. Probation on his Indiana license can be lifted once his Illinois probation has been lifted.
