**IV. INDIANA STATE NURSES ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**

Mr. Lindquist addressed the Board. ISNAP has hired a replacement for Roxanne Thomas as of October 1, 2012. ISNAP's model will be shifting to include 4 case managers so the average case load will decrease from 250 to 135 for participants in the program. Mr. Lindquist reported 39 new intakes and 26 closures this month.

**V. EDUCATION**

**A. Harrison College- Request for Additional ASN Cohort**

Staff from Harrison College was present to discuss their request for ASN program. They currently enroll one time a year and they would like to enroll in April as well. They have multiple clinical sites, are now NLNAC accredited and feel the time is right to do so. They have an additional faculty hire coming on in November and will have an additional hire prior to April. All current faculty is masters prepared. not appear for court so the charges were dismissed with prejudice so she could not bring them against Ms. Spears again. Since this time she has divorced her husband. Ms. Spears is allowed to test and license to be issued on probation for one year of active nursing with quarterly reports.

8. Mindy Pierce LPN Examination CBC Hit

Ms. Pierce appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. In 2012, she had a domestic dispute issue with husband. There was no alcohol was involved. She has had no prior arrest or no trouble since. The charges were dismissed. After this incident she contacted a counselor and is still seeing the counselor. She is allowed to test. License to be issued free and clear.

9. Scottie Gabbard LPN Examination CBC Hit

Mr. Gabbard appeared for his personal appearance regarding application for licensure. As a minor he was charged with minor in a liquor store. In 2004, he was charged with dealing in marijuana. His parents didn't support him going to college. He was struggling paying for college. His parents made to much money for him to get any grants but he was cut off by parents so he couldn't get any help. He is allowed to test, license to be issued on probation for 6 months.

Ms. Riffey appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. In 2011, she received an OWI, while in nursing school. She had gone out to bar with friends and drove home afterwards. She has never arrested before and no trouble since. She needs to contact ISNAP for an evaluation. She is allowed to test. License to be issued free and clear.

11. Teresa Alfaro RN Examination Failed 3 times

Ms. Alfaro appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. She has taken and failed the test 3 previous times. She has an issue with test anxiety. She has gone to the doctor for medication regarding the issue. She was issued a prescription and taught stress relief techniques. She needs to take a review course. Return documentation showing that she has 95% chance of passing. Once this is received she will be allowed to test and license to be issued free and clear.

12. Nicole Norlin LPN Endorsement CBC Hit

Ms. Norlin appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. In 2009, she had a failure to appear charge that was due to traffic tickets that she couldn't pay off so she did one day in jail to pay them off. She had a DUI. She was out having drinks and dinner with friends. When leaving the restaurant she got stuck in the mud. She walked home had some more drinks before returning to get the car. She was with a friend on the way back to the car and they were pulled over. She was a passenger in the car but the officer knew she had been driving earlier. She blew a .12. The charges were dropped to reckless driving. Ms. Norlin needs to contact ISNAP for an evaluation. Endorsement granted free and clear.

13. Tameka McMillian LPN Examination CBC Hit

Ms. McMillian appeared for personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. In 1999, she was charged with battery. She was 20 years old. Her mom had had a seizure. When the EMT came out there was disagreement over what was wrong with her mom. Everyone was arrested. She has been charged with carrying a handgun without permit. She was in a bar fight and a friend gave her a gun so she shot the gun in the air to scare a girl off. In 2007-2008, she had several driving while suspended charges. She was driving without a license. 8 years ago (not sure on the date) she was charged with possession of marijuana. She was riding with friends and pulled over. One of the friends had a gun so car was searched. The officer found marijuana in the car. She was convicted of possession and placed on probation. She informed her school of all this when she enrolled. She has changed her life since all of this has happened. She is allowed to test. She needs to contact ISNAP and follow recommendations they may have. Her license to be issued on probation for 1 year of active nursing, quarterly performance from supervisors.

14. Latoya Moore LPN Examination CBC Hit

Ms. Moore appeared for her personal appearance regarding application for licensure. In 2009, she had a conversion charge. She went to sears with a friend who took items from the store. She was charged because she was with her friend. She has also been arrested for driving while suspended due to license being suspend for driving without insurance. She is allowed to test, license to be issued on probation for a year of active nursing with quarterly reports.

15. Michael Angelo RN Endorsement CBC Hit

Mr. Angelo appeared for his personal appearance regarding his application for licensure. In 2002 he was charged with battery. He tapped his best friend's motorcycle with his car. In 2010 and 2011, he was charged with domestic battery. He was married for 8 months and during that time there were two altercations between him and his wife. One incident he called the cops and the other one she called but both times he was arrested. She dropped the charges both times. They are currently divorced. At this time he has a restraining order against her. Endorsement granted. License to be issued on probation for one year of active nursing. Prior

18. Caroline Maxwell RN Examination CBC Hit  
Ms. Maxwell appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application. In 2008, she was charged with theft. She and a friend stole flea medication from Myers to help a stray kitten they had found. The charges were dropped. In 2005, she was charged with battery. She was 16 and wanted to go out with friends. Her mom attempted to stop her in the drive way and there was an altercation. Her parents called police to teach her a lesson. The charges dropped. In 2008, she had a minor consumption charge. Her license had been suspended and she didn't know this. Because of the suspended license he searched her car and found alcohol in the trunk. These charges were dropped. Once she started college she found a love for learning and nursing. She realizes she went through a rough teenage period. Now has a good relationship with parents. Allow to test, license to be issued free and clear.

Ms. Mangham appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. She currently holds a license in Ohio that is on probation. She was assistant director of nursing. She knew the nursing side but was not aware of the business side. She was instructed by the HR office to take patients to the bank and help patients with their money. She found out that she was not allowed to do this. The person in HR who was instructed her to do this was later arrested for embezzlement from 4 different facilities. Endorsement in granted on probation until OH's probation is lifted.

20. Brenda Rehkopf LPN Examination Positive Response/Graduated 2009 CONTINUED

21. Angela Zook LPN Examination CBC Hit  
Ms. Zook appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. In 2011, she received a DUI. She was out drinking with friends and drove home. She was not in nursing school at the time. She received a battery charge at the same time because she kicked the officer as he was putting handcuffs on her. She has never been arrested before or since. She has already been in contact with ISNAP. She is allowed to test. She must follow through with any recommendations made by ISNAP. License to be issued free and clear.

22. Rikita Banks LPN Examination CBC Hit  
Ms. Banks appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. She had a criminal conversion when she was 18 years old. She was with some friends at Old Navy. Her friend had taken some items. She received a ticket by association. She took a diversion class and charges were dismissed. In 2006, she was investigated by ISDH as a CNA. She was working in a nursing home. She was passing trays out at lunch. One of the residents asked her to change her pants. She told the patient she would as soon as the rest of the trays were passed out. The resident ended up cutting her pants off. Another CNA told a resident that if she didn't eat she would have to eat off the floor. Ms. Banks was the CNA that got in trouble for this even though she didn't say it. Her CNA license was suspended for a year. She is currently working as a CNA and has had no issues since. Ms Sekesan appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. She has not tested in Indiana. She tested twice in MI and failed both times. Allow to test, license to be issued free and clear.

26. Laura Beckman LPN Examination Positive Response  
Ms. Beckman appeared for personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. In 1991, she had a minor possession. She was just married and husband was deployed so she was drinking. In 1991, 95, and 99, she spent a lot of time drinking and smoking marijuana. In 2005, she received a public intoxication charge. She was walking and received a ticket. She has not drank since 2009. She is allowed to test. She needs to contact ISNAP. Her license is to be issued on probation for 6 months full compliance of ISNAP RMA. If not eligible probation can be lifted right away.

Ms. Orange appeared for her personal appearance regarding her application for licensure. In 2012, she received an OWI, while in nursing school. She was out with friends and drove home. She blew a .11. She has never been arrested before or since. She needs to contact ISNAP for an evaluation. She is allowed to test and license to be issued free and clear.


