Dear Ms. Sykes,

Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-28, the Indiana Office of Small Business and Entrepreneurship (“OSBE”) has reviewed the economic impact analysis for small business associated with rule changes contained in LSA Document #13-566 proposed by The Office of the Secretary of State- Auto Dealer Services Division (“Division”). The proposed rule adds 876 IAC 5 to add definitions and fee schedule. It will add 75 IAC 6 to establish and implement the licensing and plate process and requirements for Auto Dealer Services. It will repeal 75 IAC 2 and 75 IAC 4. The proposed rule will be effective 30 days after filing with the Publisher.

The economic impact statement prepared by the Division states there will be no economic impact for small businesses to comply with the proposed rule. OSBE does not object to the economic impact to small business associated with the proposed rule.
