1. Call to Order:



1 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: This meeting of the Indiana
2 Election Commission is called to order. The
3 following members of the Commission are present:
4 Myself, Chairman Bryce Bennett; Brittany Solis,
5 Proxy for Vice Chairman Anthony Long; Member
6 Suzannah Overholt; and Member Zachary Klutz. The
7 Indiana Election Division staff are the Co --
8 Co-Directors Brad King and Angie Nussmeyer. The co
9 general counsels here are Matthew Kochevar and Dale
10 Simmons. The court reporter today is Lisa Pierce
11 with Connor Reporting.

12 And at this time I would ask for documentation
13 of compliance with the Open Door Laws and request
14 Mr. King and Ms. Nussmeyer to confirm that the
15 Commission Meeting has been properly noticed as
16 required under the Open Door Law.

17 MR. KING: Mr. Chairman, Members of the
18 Commission, notice of this meeting was posted in
19 compliance with the Open Door Law.

20 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: I recognize Mr. King and
21 Miss Nussmeyer to present the minutes from the
22 November 2nd, 2017 Commission Meeting.

23 MR. KING: Mr. Chairman, Members of the
24 Commission, the minutes of the November 2nd, 2017
25 meeting were reviewed and submitted to you all by

1 Co-Director Nussmeyer and myself. And we
2 respectfully recommend your approval.

3 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Is there a motion to
4 approve the minutes as presented?

5 MR. KLUTZ: So moved.

6 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Have a motion. Is there a
7 second?

8 MS. SOLIS: Second.

9 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: A motion and a second. Is
10 there any discussion? Hearing none, all in favor
11 say, "Aye."

12 THE COMMISSION: Aye.

13 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Aye. All opposed say,
14 "Nay." The ayes have it and the motion to approve
15 the minutes is adopted. I will sign the minutes as
16 approved.

17 Like to call for ratification of Campaign
18 Finance Settlement Agreements presented by
19 Ms. Taylor and Ms. Thompson.

20 MS. THOMPSON: Mr. Chairman, Members of the
21 Commission, in your binder, under the Campaign
22 Finance Tab, there's a committee to ratify that has
23 agreed to pay the Settlement Agreement -- Agreement
24 and waive the hearing.

25 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Is there a motion to ratify

1 this Settlement Agreement?

2 MR. KLUTZ: So moved.

3 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Motion.

4 MS. OVERHOLT: Second.

5 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Motion and a second. Any
6 discussion? Hearing none, all in favor say, "Aye."

7 THE COMMISSION: Aye.

8 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Aye. All opposed say,
9 "Nay." Ayes have it; motion is adopted.

10 Everyone present who plans to testify
11 regarding any matter coming before the Commission
12 today, including campaign finance or voting system
13 matters, please stand for the administration of the
14 oath. And recognize Dale Simmons to administer the
15 oath.

16 MR. SIMMONS: Raise your right hand and say "I
17 do" after administration of the oath.

18 (After the administration of the oath,
19 the following proceedings were had:)

20 ALL TESTIFYING: I do.

21 MR. SIMMONS: Thank you.

22 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Thank you. I would ask for
23 presentations by Mr. King and Ms. Nussmeyer
24 regarding the approval of the Dubois County
25 Precinct Establishment Order.

1 MS. NUSSMEYER: Mr. Chairman, if I may. Clerk
2 Jarboe is here from Dubois County. And if I am --
3 I will briefly go over sort of what their request
4 was. And if I get anything factually incorrect,
5 you'll stop me, I'm sure. Patrick Becker, who is
6 my Director of Special Projects, is out this week
7 recuperating from oral surgery. And so I'm doing
8 my best to pitch in here.

9 So, as I understand, you had six precincts or
10 six precinct boundary changes that were submitted
11 to the office.

12 MR. JARBOE: Yes.

13 MS. NUSSMEYER: And those six precinct
14 boundary changes were related to annexations. So
15 the City, I suppose, got a little bit -- little bit
16 larger. And so in order to accommodate those
17 precincts -- the City annexations, those precinct
18 boundaries were adjusted so that the County would
19 not have to split a precinct and create a situation
20 where you'd have a -- one ballot that -- for half
21 of the precinct that would be for the County and
22 the other half of the -- the precinct for the City.

23 As I understand, her commissioners are
24 supportive. She's informed both of her Demo -- the
25 Democratic and Republican Party Chairs at the

1 County about the precinct changes. And the County
2 Chairs are supportive, as I understand. And that
3 she did attempt publication of the notice in the
4 newspaper.

5 And, as I understand, the publisher encouraged
6 you to publish after January 1st in order to get
7 more eyeballs on the notice itself. And the
8 unfortunate side of doing that meant that the
9 ten-day public comment period expires on -- at noon
10 January 12th, which we needed it to expire no later
11 than noon January 9th.

12 And so Clerk Jarboe is here to answer any
13 questions that you all may have about the precinct
14 order. And if anybody from the public is here to
15 comment, they may certainly do so as well.

16 MR. KING: Mr. Chairman, I'll add, both
17 Co-Director Nussmeyer and myself reviewed the
18 submission made by Dubois County in this matter,
19 following review by the Office of Census Data
20 Legislative Services, and found that it complied
21 with Indiana law. Your binders contain an order
22 signed by both of us attesting to that effect.

23 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Very good. Thank you.
24 Clerk Jarboe, do you want to add anything at this
25 point?

1 MR. JARBOE: I do want to add -- and thank you
2 all, and thank you for having me this afternoon.
3 This -- this will honestly affect twenty voters,
4 fifteen active and five inactive, that are already
5 in a split precinct. The rest are -- is all
6 annexation of land at this time that would miss it.
7 The fifteen people that are currently active voters
8 are moving into the annexation's precinct, or where
9 they are now, so we can eliminate an extra ballot
10 style.

11 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Very good. Thank you. Any
12 questions from the Commissioners?

13 MS. OVERHOLT: Actually, well, just for
14 clarification. So by doing this today, if the
15 public comment period needed to end the 9th --

16 MS. NUSSMEYER: Uh-huh.

17 MS. OVERHOLT: -- which is Tuesday, right?
18 And today's the -- if we're acting today, we're
19 kind of -- aren't we cutting short the public
20 comment period?

21 MS. NUSSMEYER: Correct. So according to law
22 what should have happened is that public notice be
23 published in the newspaper to allow for a ten-day
24 public comment period.

25 MS. OVERHOLT: Uh-huh.

1 MS. NUSSMEYER: And if no one from the public
2 would submit a comment to our office, then Brad and
3 I would sign a final order to send to the County.

4 By holding the hearing today, we're
5 essentially allowing the public to come to
6 Indianapolis and to submit their comment for us to
7 discuss here -- or for the Commission to discuss
8 today to determine whether or not there was any
9 sort of concern from the public as to whether or
10 not the precinct boundary changes should go into
11 effect.

12 So essentially what we are doing or what the
13 Commission would do, should they approve the
14 request, would be circumventing the public comment
15 period through a published legal notice.

16 MS. OVERHOLT: And how was the public notified
17 of this meeting? How were the -- how were the
18 voters in Dubois County notified of this meeting?

19 MS. NUSSMEYER: Brad and I published notice of
20 the meeting within 48 hours, as required under
21 State law, for the Commission to hold this hearing.
22 And then I believe it's not just posted outside but
23 also on our Web site as well.

24 MR. KING: I'll add it was posted
25 simultaneously on the Web site.

1 MS. OVERHOLT: But that's the only way the
2 voters would know though would be to come to the
3 Web site or to stand outside this --

4 MS. NUSSMEYER: Uh-huh.

5 MS. OVERHOLT: -- the door and --

6 MR. KING: That would be correct.

7 MS. OVERHOLT: And I take it no comment had
8 been received regarding this?

9 MR. KING: No.

10 MS. NUSSMEYER: Huh-uh.

11 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Any other questions?
12 Hearing none, is there a motion to approve the
13 proposed Dubois County Precinct Establishment Order
14 as presented, Order Number 2018-1?

15 MR. KLUTZ: So moved.

16 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Is there a second?

17 MS. SOLIS: Second.

18 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: The motion is seconded.
19 Any further discussion? Hearing none, all in favor
20 say, "Aye."

21 THE COMMISSION: Aye.

22 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Aye. All opposed say,
23 "Nay." The ayes have it and the order is approved.
24 Thank you very much.

25 MR. JARBOE: Thank you.

1 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Now we have the approval of
2 the Posey County Precinct Establishment Order
3 2018-2. And I would ask for a presentation by
4 Mr. King and Ms. Nussmeyer.

5 MS. NUSSMEYER: Mr. Chairman and Members of
6 the Commission, Clerk Postletheweight from Posey
7 County is here this afternoon as well. And, again,
8 I will do my very best to try to be reflective of
9 what I understand to be true in Posey County. So
10 please correct me if I am wrong.

11 I believe there are three precincts that are
12 having boundary impacts that were submitted to the
13 office. And as Brad mentioned with -- much like
14 Dubois County, we also reviewed those -- that
15 request and submitted it to the Office of Census
16 Data. Those boundary changes were reflective of
17 annexations, again, City annexations so that the
18 County could avoid having a split precinct where
19 part of the voters would have City offices and the
20 other half County offices, which can often lead to
21 confusion on election day with our poll workers.

22 As I understand, both County Party Chairs are
23 supportive. In fact, I spoke to the Posey County
24 Democratic Chair this morning on another matter.
25 And he was aware that Clerk Postletheweight was

1 coming up and was -- signaled his support for the
2 reprecincting effort in Posey County.

3 And, as I understand, you too published
4 notice, but it was on January 2nd.

5 MS. POSTLETHEWEIGHT: Yes.

6 MS. NUSSMEYER: So, again, there was legal
7 notice published in the newspaper on January 2nd.
8 But the public comment period would end on
9 January 12th. But I also believe to be true that
10 you published notice this summer --

11 MS. POSTLETHEWEIGHT: Yes.

12 MS. NUSSMEYER: -- as well, at the start of
13 this project.

14 MS. POSTLETHEWEIGHT: Yes.

15 MS. NUSSMEYER: So the -- the county was
16 notified a little early, if you will, that the
17 precinct changes were coming. But that was before
18 our office and the Office of Census Data had the
19 opportunity to review that request.

20 And so Posey County had two notices published.
21 Just the second one was the more important one, and
22 that's the one that was published on January 2nd.
23 With that, Clerk Postlethweight, or if anyone else
24 has comment to add.

25 MS. POSTLETHEWEIGHT: No. We sent -- we had

1 eight registered voters in that area. Two of them
2 are actually in that area now. So we don't have a
3 lot of voters in that area. This comes as an
4 annexation, like she said, from the City taking
5 from the County.

6 I have an agreement where, when I spoke with
7 the Commissioners about it, that the Democrat
8 Election Board member and the Republican one were
9 both in agreement. I have from the Democrat
10 Chairman that he's full -- fully approved of it.
11 'Cause it's his -- it's his street that was -- was
12 -- was involved. He's fully supportive of it. So,
13 yeah, we don't -- we don't have any problems.

14 And I'm sorry that we didn't get it in sooner.
15 But we got the notice. We have a newspaper that
16 publishes once a week. Had to be in by the 20th,
17 and I didn't make the deadline. You know, it's the
18 way it was. Got it in as soon as we could. So --

19 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Okay. Thank you. Any --

20 MS. POSTLETHEWEIGHT: Welcome.

21 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: -- questions from the
22 Commissioners?

23 MR. KLUTZ: I -- is there a statutory deadline
24 that we're bumping up against that is requiring
25 this meeting?

1 MR. KING: Yes. Commissioner, the statutory
2 deadline is actually January 10th.

3 MR. KLUTZ: Okay.

4 MR. KING: Because that's the start of
5 candidate filing.

6 MR. KLUTZ: Okay.

7 MR. KING: And this year the Democratic Party
8 elects Precinct Committeemen. And both parties
9 choose State Convention Delegates that sometimes
10 have delegate districts based on precincts.

11 MR. KLUTZ: Okay. So that's why their --
12 their notices don't work.

13 MR. KING: That's correct.

14 MR. KLUTZ: Okay.

15 MS. OVERHOLT: I guess I'll just -- and I take
16 it there hasn't been any comment received by the
17 office.

18 MS. NUSSMEYER: No. I'm not aware of any.

19 MR. KING: That's correct.

20 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: And you've told us about
21 the comments that you've received already.

22 MS. POSTLETHEWEIGHT: It only affects -- we --
23 we notified each voter individually that it would
24 effect. And two of them responded that they are
25 still there. The rest of them we got no response

1 from. So I do not believe -- and I've checked the
2 rolls; they are no longer registered voters. So it
3 only affects two people unless some of these other
4 people have moved out and other people have moved
5 in. And they would accept it, I'm sure.

6 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Okay. Any further
7 discussion?

8 MS. OVERHOLT: No.

9 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Hearing none, is there a
10 motion?

11 MS. SOLIS: So moved.

12 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: This is a motion to approve
13 the Posey County Precinct Establishment Order as
14 presented, Order Number 2018-2; is that correct?

15 MS. SOLIS: Yes, sir.

16 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Is there a second?

17 MR. KLUTZ: Second.

18 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Motion and a second. Any
19 further discussion? Hearing none, all in favor
20 say, "Aye."

21 THE COMMISSION: Aye.

22 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Aye. All opposed say,
23 "Nay." Ayes have it; motion carries; order is
24 approved. Thank you very much.

25 MS. POSTLETHEWEIGHT: Thank you. We

1 appreciate it.

2 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Is there a motion to
3 authorize staff to affix Commission Member
4 signatures on the Commission Orders approved today?

5 MR. KLUTZ: So moved.

6 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Is there a second?

7 MS. SOLIS: Second.

8 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Motion and a second. Any
9 discussion? All in favor say, "Aye."

10 THE COMMISSION: Aye.

11 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Aye. All opposed say,
12 "Nay." The ayes have it; motion carried.

13 The Election Commission has finished its
14 business for today. Is there a motion for the
15 Indiana Election Commission to adjourn?

16 MS. SOLIS: I move that we move to
17 adjournment, please.

18 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Is there a second?

19 MR. KLUTZ: Second.

20 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: The motion is seconded.
21 Any -- any discussion? Hearing none, those in
22 favor say, "Aye."

23 THE COMMISSION: Aye.

24 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Aye. All opposed say,
25 "Nay." Motion carried. We are adjourned. Thank

1 you.
