1 things to try to figure out how to correct my  
2 voting record.

3 And then on the Friday after the filings --  
4 I filed on the last day because the candidate  
5 that was supposed to run to represent a group of  
6 us had sought out a candidate, did not file.

7 So on Thursday night, we had to file. I  
8 came in Friday morning to file and make sure we  
9 had somebody to represent the group in the  
10 primary.

11 And so what happened was I got on at the  
12 last second because of that, which didn't leave  
13 any room for wiggle room here.

14 So on the Friday -- I learned on I think  
15 the Wednesday or Thursday of the official  
16 challenge -- no. That was the rumor, or I heard  
17 it through the grapevine.

18 And I went to Ms. Bradford on Friday, not  
19 knowing that she was going to make the  
20 challenge, because I hadn't seen it officially,  
21 and asked about being put -- to be validated, to  
22 be on.

23 I can show you my credentials from South  
24 Carolina. I was a Republican -- county  
25 Republican. And, if I can approach here, I'll

2           Thankfully, some people from South Carolina  
3 finally responded. They're all very busy with  
4 their primary coming up.

5           VICE CHAIRMAN LONG: Tomorrow.

6           MR. BALL: Yes. This one -- just for the  
7 record, this one actually has the seal, if you  
8 want to enter that into the record. I'd like to  
9 keep the original, if I can. But if not, that's  
10 the original.

11           It's a statement from the secretary of the  
12 Republican Party there in Spartanburg County  
13 that -- it's his personal blurb about working  
14 together with me, and my official record with  
15 the party, where I was, precinct president,  
16 precinct committeeman, state delegate, national  
17 delegate 2012.

18           And then you can see the rest. Spartanburg  
19 County GOP, communications, and precinct  
20 president and executive committeeman again, and  
21 state delegate.

22           As well as it's certified, most  
23 importantly, that in 2012 and 2014 in South  
24 Carolina -- I know it's not Indiana. I know  
25 what the statute says. This is what I've got to

2 In 2012 and 2014, I did vote in the primary  
3 elections in South Carolina. And those two  
4 pages that follow are the documentation from the  
5 election committee in South Carolina.

6 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Any cross-examination?

7 MS. BRADFORD: No.

8 VICE CHAIRMAN LONG: Can I make an  
9 observation? Just because I like to see young  
10 people involved, and you've obviously been  
11 involved. The statute -- and maybe they ought  
12 to consider that if you went here or if you  
13 voted here --

14 MR. BALL: I agree.

15 VICE CHAIRMAN LONG: -- voted in a  
16 Democratic primary, moved out of state for 25  
17 years and were governor of another state in the  
18 Republican Party --

19 MR. BALL: I agree.

20 VICE CHAIRMAN LONG: -- filed in Indiana.

21 I also remember a case that's a little  
22 different than yours. I was on the Commission  
23 then. I think there were three or four counties  
24 that that district entailed. And every one of  
25 the county chairmen in these counties came to

2 know, if we weren't aware --

3 MR. BALL: Yeah, I agree. And I think --

4 VICE CHAIRMAN LONG: -- would have probably  
5 kept her off. The Commission at that time voted  
6 because she had those people there --

7 MR. BALL: -- Commission, I think, voted  
8 that way because of the spirit of the law, why  
9 we're supposed to -- I mean the rules are there  
10 for the right purpose.

11 And that's why the Commission is here as  
12 well, to look at it and judge it individually  
13 and say, "Does this apply?"

14 The disenfranchisement's clearly going to  
15 happen here if I'm not on the ballot in the  
16 primary. The incumbent will be unopposed.

17 I believe in the lieutenant governor's  
18 case, even though she did have the backing of  
19 the other party chairs, there was not an  
20 incumbent. As all of you can imagine, it's  
21 rather hard to get backing of anyone when  
22 there's an incumbent. Nobody wants to put their  
23 name on it and risk their neck.

24 VICE CHAIRMAN LONG: Please stay active.

25 MR. BALL: What?

2 MR. BALL: Oh, I absolutely will.

3 But, you know, again, for me, I'm really  
4 here at this point in representing 55 not even  
5 elected, because I think they need a vote in

7 people all got together. When he didn't file as  
8 of Thursday night, I showed up Friday morning to  
9 make sure we had a candidate on the ballot.

10 So I would ask that as in the lieutenant  
11 governor's case, I be allowed to stay on the  
12 ballot so that the voters have a choice and  
13 don't have disenfranchisement.

14 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Any other questions?

15 (No response.)

16 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Is there a motion?

17 MS. BRADFORD: May I say something?

18 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Yes, please.

19 MS. BRADFORD: We do have someone running  
20 on that ticket.

21 VICE CHAIRMAN LONG: I gathered from his  
22 comment.

23 MR. BALL: Yeah. And I just don't believe  
24 that someone already being on the ticket should  
25 preclude to eliminate someone else from being on

2 VICE CHAIRMAN LONG: The problem is, you've  
3 got to have the county chairman's approval.

4 My wife would be awful upset with me  
5 because she's the county chairman in our county.  
6 So I try to be consistent.

7 Please stay active. We need young people.

8 MR. BALL: I hear that a lot.

9 COMMISSION MEMBER KLUTZ: I do wish it said  
10 last primary election in the state in which you  
11 resided.

12 VICE CHAIRMAN LONG: That, I think, makes  
13 some sense.

14 He said that he thought it ought to say,  
15 "The last primary election in the state in which  
16 I resided," and I agree with that. I thought  
17 that made some sense.

18 Unfortunately, it does not say that.

19 MR. BALL: But as the lieutenant governor's  
20 case in front of the Commission, the Commission  
21 still was able to make the decision to let her  
22 stay on the ballot. She didn't have any  
23 primary, in state or out of state, after she  
24 voted Democrat.

25 I actually have primaries -- they were out

1 of state, but still, a better scenario than the  
2 governor had -- lieutenant governor at the time,  
3 obviously.

4 So the Commission at that point saw fit to  
5 let her stay on the ballot when, in 2008, she  
6 voted Democrat, 2010 there had been no other  
7 votes, other than her Republican credential.

8 COMMISSION MEMBER KLUTZ: The key  
9 difference was the county chairman allowing --

10 MR. BALL: I agree. And that's why I did  
11 approach Ms. Bradford on that Friday after, to  
12 get vouched.

13 I'm not really clear why -- why there was  
14 no willingness, from my perception, to sit down  
15 and look at this information, and let me show  
16 proof, and that type of thing. But there was  
17 not the willingness to hear this piece of it,  
18 and to look at it to be validated. She would  
19 not validate me at that point.

20 So I had no point -- or no choice but to  
21 show up here with the evidence of my Republican  
22 credentials and lay it out for the Commission,  
23 hoping for the same thing we had happen in 2010.

24 CHAIRMAN BENNETT: Well, you've done a good  
25 job of that. And I echo the comments of Vice

3 But how we decide here is indicative of our

5 MR. BALL: And the law affords you the

9 under the facts and the scenario.

10 I'll make a motion to sustain the  
11 challenge.


